ORDER

10.03.2026. Anticipatory Bail petition filed on behalf of the accused/petitioners namely 1. Bardelal Singh @ Brajmohan Pal, 2. Titu Singh @ Kartik Kumar, 3. Lal Singh @ Himanshu Shekhar, 4. Satish Singh @ Ramnarayan, 5. Santu Singh and 6. Chhotu Singh @ Chandra Shekhar Kumar who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Mehush P.S. Case No. 04/2026, under sections – 191(2), 190, 126(2), 127(2), 116(2), 109(1), 304(2), 324(2), 351(2), 352 of B.N.S & Sec. 25(1-b) (a) 26, 35 Arms Act, is moved today.

Heard the learned Counsel for the petitioner and the learned Addl. P.P. for the state.

A.B.P. No. 74/2026.

The prosecution case in brief is that informant Rampravesh Kumar, S/o Pramod Yadav, village Barui, P.S Sheikhpura, District Sheikhpura, stating therein that on dated 19.01.2026 at about 8:30 P.M, Informant was going to Mafo village for his nephew's birthday. As soon he reached Mehus Chowk, some people started chasing him on a motorcycle. He ran and reached the Mafo Durga Temple, thinking he was safe. Then they surrounded him and started assaulting him on the head with the butt of a pistol, with the intending to kill. They assaulted him with lathi-danda, rods, and khanti and marks on his head, leaving severe bruises in several places, and he was covered in blood. Then they snatched a chain weighted one and a half bhar from his neck. When he tried to call his family, they broke his mobile phone and started assaulting his younger brother, Sachin. In the meantime, two or four people came with weapons and caught his uncle's son, Karan Kumar and started assaulting him with the butt of the pistol. They took him with them with the intention of killing him and making him disappear. Then his younger brother Sachin reached his sister's house and told everything. Then 10-20 people of the village went there and they abused and said that everyone run away or else they will kill. Then they identified that all of them are from Mafo village 1. Barelal Singh, 2. Tiku Singh, 3. Lal Singh, 4. Satish Singh, 5. Santu Singh, 6. Chhotu Singh @ Khushboo Singh and 7. Chhote Singh all residents of Mafo, Post Office-Mafo, P.S - Mehus, District – Sheikhpura, all of them were assaulting Karan Kumar. When Karan Kumar was being assaulted, then in the same sequence one of the people was saying that Bade Da, do not leave him, kill him. Later, the police rescued his cousin Karan Kumar in an injured condition from the same house and admitted all three of them to Sadar Hospital where they are swinging between the life and death.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent and have not committed any offence as alleged in the FIR. It has been further submitted that earlier on behalf of the petitioners neither ABP nor regular bail petition has been filed either in this Ld. Court or the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. It has been further submitted that petitoners submitted that they have no criminal antecedent except this aforesaid case and Mehush P.S Case No. 24/20 pending against the petitioners but Titu Singh has no criminal antecedent. It has been further submitted that prosecution case is neither truth nor believable rather due to dirty village politics and previous enmity petitioners have been falsely implicated in this false case. It has been further submitted that

informant of this case is a notorious criminal and always he does involve in road robbery and on the alleged day he was also involved in the road robbery. It has been further submitted that informant and his associates were committing robbery on the road and on information when villager were chased them away they all ran away stumbling and tripping over. It has been further submitted that this false case brought by the informant to save his neck from robbery incident. It has been further submitted that petitioners undertake that they shall co-operate in the investigation and shall be present before the court on every fixed date. It has been further submitted that petitioners undertake they they shall co-operate in the investigation and will be present before this court on every fixed date. It has been further submitted that petitioners are respectable persons and they are ready to furnish the bail bond along with undertaking of 482(2) of the B.N.S.S

The learned Addl. P.P. for the state vehemently opposed the prayer of bail. He further submitted that three persons are injured. The injury caused to the Karan Kumar is grievous in nature. Injury is caused on the head of the informant which is the vital part of the body.

I have heard the rival submission of both the parties and perused the record along with the case diary. The allegation against the petitioners are that they assaulted the informant and his brothers due to which they sustained injuries. The allegation of the informant corroborates with the injury reports. Three persons are injured so the occurrence cannot be denied. Multiple injuries has been caused to the informant and his brothers. As per injury report of injured Karan Kumar the doctor has opined that Nature of injury No 1 is grievous in nature & Injury No. 2, 3 and 4 are simple in nature. There is sufficient material in the case diary to show the complicity of the accused petitioners in the alleged offences. Investigation is in progress. As para 20 of the case diary the Petitioner No. 1, namely, Barelal Singh @ Brajmohan Pal, Petitioner No. 3, namely, Lal Singh @ Himanshu Shekhar, Petitioner No. 4, Satish Singh @ Ramnarayan and Petitioner No. 5, namely, Santu Singh have criminal antecedents.

Considering the above mentioned facts and circumstance of the case, nature of allegation, gravity of the offence, nature of injuries, materials available on the record and investigation is in progress, I am not inclined to enlarge the accused petitioners on bail. Accordingly prayer for grant bail of the accused petitioners namely 1. Barelal Singh @ Brajmohan Pal, 2. Titu Singh @ Kartik Kumar, 3. Lal Singh @ Himanshu Shekhar, 4. Satish

Singh @ Ramnarayan, 5. Santu Singh and 6. Chhotu Singh @ Chandra Shekhar Kumar are hereby rejected.

Any observation made herein will be inconsequential during trial or any further stage of the case.
