ORDER

10.03.2026 Bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused petitioners Rajan Singh @ Rajan Kumar and Suraj Kumar under custody since 17.02.2026 in connection with Korma P.S. Case No. 80/2024. The present case has been registered against the unknown for committing the offence U/s. 303(2) of B.N.S. During the course of investigation, the name of accused petitioners came in this case with the allegation that they have committed the alleged offence of theft. Hence, they have moved this bail petition U/s. 483 of B.N.S.S-2023. Ld. P.P. submitted case diary.

As per written report of informant Indu Devi, prosecution story in brief is that on 01.07.2024 at about 7:00 P.M., her tractor, bearing registration number BR52G5414, chassis number MBNBU53AANCH27363, and engine motor number EZ.400/SEH26976, was parked by the driver near the Kachra Bhawan Korma in Diriya Khandha. On 02.07.2024 at 8:00 A.M., when the driver went there, he saw that the tractor was missing from there, then the driver told her husband Ramshankar Singh about the tractor and they searched for the tractor but could not find it. She believes that unknown thieves have stolen her tractor.

Learned Advocate for the petitioners has submitted that petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence, rather they have been falsely implicated in this case. Earlier, the accused petitioners have not filed any bail petition before this Court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna. Petitioner No. 1 has one criminal antecedent vide Shambho

10.03.2026 P.S. Case No. 13/2017 U/s. 302 of I.P.C. and the Petitioner No. 2 has no criminal antecedent. The petitioners are not the ones named in the FIR and have been made accused due to the malafide intentions of the police. During the investigation, the I.O. of this case arrested four accused on 20.07.2024, and the arrested accused disclosed the names of the accused petitioners in their confession. The said stolen tractor bearing registration No. BR52G5414 was seized from village Bijullia, P.S. Shambho, District Begusarai, near Shiv Mandir. The petitioners have no concern with this occurrence, and they have not been involved in this case. The seized tractor has not been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners. The petitioners have not committed such a type of offence as alleged against them. There is not sufficient and cogent evidence against the petitioners. Other co-accused persons, namely 1. Shiv Kumar @ Fudan Singh 2. Nilesh Kumar @ Chhotu Kumar 3. Ujjawal Kumar @ Nanhujee 4. Sonam Kumar @ Raviraj Singh has been granted regular bail by this Court vide B.P. No. 931/2024, B.P. No. 1055/2024, B.P. No. 1069/2024 and B.P. No. 1258/2024, respectively, and the cases of the petitioners are of similar footing. The accused petitioners are in judicial custody since 17.02.2026.

Ld. P.P. opposed the prayer for bail and has submitted that accused petitioners are involved in the alleged crime.

Heard the learned Advocate for the accused petitioners as well as Ld. Public Prosecutor and perused the record. From perusal of the case record, it transpires that the accused petitioners are not named in the FIR, during the course of investigation the name of accused petitioners came in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused who were arrested by the police on 20.07.2024. There is no eyewitness against the accused petitioners and nothing has been seized from the conscious possession of the accused petitioners. From the perusal of record, it appears that the stolen tractor bearing registration number BR52G5414 was recovered from village Bijullia, P.S. Shambho, District Begusarai, near Shiv Mandir on 02.07.2024. It is a case U/s. 303(2) of B.N.S., which is punishable with a maximum sentence of three years. From perusal of case record, it appears that four co-accused namely namely Shiv Kumar @ Fudan Singh, Nilesh Kumar @ Chhotu

10.03.2026 Kumar, Ujjawal Kumar @ Nanhujee & Sonam Kumar @ Raviraj Singh, who were arrested by the police and named the accused petitioners, have been granted regular bail by the then Ld. District & Sessions Judge, Sheikhpura vide B.P. No. 931/2024, B.P. No. 1055/2024, B.P. No. 1069/2024 and B.P. No. 1258/2024 respectively. The case of the present petitioners are of similar footing. From perusal of record, it appears that there is no criminal record of theft or robbery against the accused petitioners. Further the accused petitioners are in judicial custody since 17.02.2026. Considering the above facts and circumstances, the present bail petition of accused petitioners Rajan Singh @ Rajan Kumar and Suraj Kumar is hereby allowed and accused petitioners Rajan Singh @ Rajan Kumar and Suraj Kumar be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court, subject to the condition that –

- 1. One of the sureties shall be close relative of accused petitioners.**
- 2. Accused petitioners shall appear before the Ld. Trial Court on each and every dates till framing of the charge.**
- 3. Accused petitioners shall provide their mobile numbers and Whats App numbers in writing to the Ld. Trial Court at the time of furnishing bail bond, and shall also undertake not to change their mobile numbers until the trial is concluded without the permission of the Ld. Trial Court.**
