**ORDER**

**10.03.2026** Bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused petitioners Sanjeet Kumar and Vibhuti Kumar under custody since 19.02.2026 in connection with Sheikhpura Cyber P.S. Case No. 12/2026. The present case has been registered against the accused petitioners for committing the offence U/s. 318(4), 319(2), 336(2), 336(3), 340(2), 3(5) of B.N.S & 66C/66D I.T Act-2000. The present petitioners are also named in the F.I.R with the allegation that they have committed the alleged offence of cyber fraud. Hence, they have moved this bail petition U/s. 483 of B.N.S.S-2023. Ld. P.P. submitted case diary.

As per self-statement of Sub-Inspector Ganesh Prasad Suman, prosecution story in brief is that on 18.02.2026, at about 08:30 A.M., he received information that some cyber fraudsters were operating in Panchi village and could be caught red-handed if a raid was conducted. He, along with Constable Shiv Shankar Kumar and Constable Shashi Bhushan Kumar, along with the police station's day patrol team, went to the specified location at about 10:00 A.M. to verify the information and conduct a raid to take necessary action. Upon seeing the police vehicle on the main road near the Hanuman Temple in Panchi village's West Tola, two youths began running and were apprehended with the help of the accompanying police force. When asked for their names, the arrested youths gave their names as Sanjeet Kumar and Vibhuti Kumar. When asked the reason for their escape, the arrested youths were unable to give any clear information. On suspicion, it was deemed appropriate to search the arrested youth. In this sequence, the relatives of the arrested youth, Chandeshwar Das and Subelal Das came, and considering them as independent witnesses, the arrested youth were searched. During the search, a light brown Motorola mobile phone was found in the left pocket of Sanjeet Kumar's jeans, and a black-blue Vivo mobile phone was found in the right pocket of his jeans. Two mobile phones were found in Vibhuti Kumar's left hand: a cream-coloured Realme mobile phone and a sky-blue Realme mobile phone. A black Redmi mobile phone was found lying on the ground in a switched-

**10.03.2026** off condition. When all the mobiles were checked, it was found that voice chats and text chats of many people related to cyber fraud were found in all of them. When all the seized mobiles were checked with the help of technical assistance, it was found that a light grey-coloured Motorola company mobile was recovered from the left pocket of Sanjeet Kumar with IMEI (Slot-1) 3501224297183339/43, Mobile No.-7761801298, Holder-Sanjeet Kumar, and IMEI (Slot-2) 3501224297183347/43, and from his right pocket a black-blue coloured Vivo company mobile IMEI (Slot-1): 860192049456670 Mobile No. - 6201580550 Holder - Dilkush Kumar IMEI (Slot-2) - 860192049456662 Mobile No. - 7870383284 Holder - Radha Kumari, in which Facebook was found active in the name of Bihari Baba, through which people are cheated in the name of Vashikaran. Along with this, several text/voice chats were found on WhatsApp related to defrauding people by sending scanners in the name of old coins/vashikaran puja-path. Two mobile phones were recovered from Vibhuti Kumar – a cream-coloured Realme mobile with IMEI (slot-1) 869922071938257/18 and IMEI (slot-2) 869922071938240/18, mobile number 9304857675, holder Sumant Kumar; and a sky blue coloured Realme mobile with IMEI (slot-1) 866624052378031/19, mobile number 7545054153, holder Veera Kumari; and IMEI (slot-2) 866624052378023/19, in which technical investigation of Facebook/Insta IDs in the names of Radha Kumari, Bihari Baba, Vashikaran, Tantrik Vashikaran, and Sandeep Shastri revealed that fraud was being committed by running fake Facebook IDs, Instagram IDs and YouTube channels from all the mobiles and contacting people in the name of "Vashikaran Mantra, Puja-Path, purchase of old coins", etc. and sending scanners through WhatsApp. Evidence of cyber fraud was found through voice and text chats on the mobile phone. A locked black Redmi phone was found lying on the ground, containing SIM cards from Airtel and Jio, which could not be unlocked. Sanjeet Kumar and Vibhuti Kumar were interrogated after being caught in this case. In this regard, both of them told that they commit cyber fraud by making videos and posts in the name of Vashikaran Mantra, Puja-Path on fake Facebook IDs, Instagram and YouTube and contacting people through WhatsApp and asking for huge amount of money in exchange for old coins.

Learned Advocate for the petitioners has submitted that petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence, rather they have been falsely implicated in this case. Prior to this bail petition, accused petitioners have not filed any bail petition before this Court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The accused petitioners have no criminal antecedents. The petitioners have been implicated in this case on the instigation of enemies due to village politics. The petitioner Vibhuti Kumar, a student of the BA class, is preparing for a competitive examination to

**10.03.2026** reside at Bihar Sharif. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners. All the seized articles do not belong to petitioners. The informant produced all articles as false and fabricated to make the false cyber case against the petitioners. The petitioners are law-abiding persons, and they are ready to obey every direction of Court. The accused petitioners are in judicial custody since 19.02.2026.

Ld. P.P. strongly opposed the prayer for bail and has submitted that accused petitioners are involved in cyber crime and they cheats innocent people. Five mobiles were recovered from both the accused. The seized mobiles were checked, it was found that a light grey-coloured Motorola company mobile was recovered from Sanjeet Kumar with IMEI (Slot-1) 3501224297183339/43, Mobile No.-7761801298, and IMEI (Slot-2) 3501224297183347/43, and a black-blue coloured Vivo company mobile IMEI (Slot-1): 860192049456670 Mobile No. - 6201580550 Holder - Dilkush Kumar IMEI (Slot-2) - 860192049456662 Mobile No. - 7870383284, in which Facebook was found active in the name of Bihari Baba, through which people are cheated in the name of Vashikaran. Along with this, several text/voice chats were found on WhatsApp related to defrauding people by sending scanners in the name of old coins/vashikaran puja-path. Two mobile phones were recovered from Vibhuti Kumar – a cream-coloured Realme mobile with IMEI (slot-1) 869922071938257/18 and IMEI (slot-2) 869922071938240/18, mobile number 9304857675, and a sky blue coloured Realme mobile with IMEI (slot-1) 866624052378031/19, mobile number 7545054153, and IMEI (slot-2) 866624052378023/19, in which technical investigation of Facebook/Insta IDs in the names of Radha Kumari, Bihari Baba, Vashikaran, Tantrik Vashikaran, and Sandeep Shastri revealed that fraud was being committed by running fake Facebook IDs, Instagram IDs and YouTube channels from all the mobiles and contacting people in the name of "Vashikaran Mantra, Puja-Path, purchase of old coins", etc. and sending scanners through WhatsApp. Evidence of cyber fraud was found through voice and text chats on the mobile phone.

Heard the learned Advocate for the accused petitioners as well as Ld. Public Prosecutor and perused the record. From perusal of case record, it transpires that accused petitioners are involved in the cyber crime. There is direct allegation against the accused petitioners that they cheats innocent people. From perusal of F.I.R. and case diary, it appears that five mobile phones were seized from the accused petitioners. A light brown Motorola mobile phone was found in the left pocket of Sanjeet Kumar's jeans, and a black-blue Vivo mobile phone was found in the right pocket of his jeans. Two mobile phones were found in Vibhuti Kumar's left hand: a cream-coloured Realme mobile phone and

**10.03.2026** a sky-blue Realme mobile phone. A black Redmi mobile phone was found lying on the ground in a switched-off condition. When all the mobiles were checked, it was found that voice chats and text chats of many people related to cyber fraud were found in all of them. When all the seized mobiles were checked with the help of technical assistance, it was found that a light grey-coloured Motorola company mobile was recovered from the left pocket of Sanjeet Kumar with IMEI (Slot-1) 3501224297183339/43, Mobile No.-7761801298, Holder-Sanjeet Kumar, and IMEI (Slot-2) 3501224297183347/43, and from his right pocket a black-blue coloured Vivo company mobile IMEI (Slot-1): 860192049456670 Mobile No. - 6201580550 Holder - Dilkush Kumar IMEI (Slot-2) - 860192049456662 Mobile No. - 7870383284 Holder - Radha Kumari, in which Facebook was found active in the name of Bihari Baba, through which people are cheated in the name of Vashikaran. Along with this, several text/voice chats were found on WhatsApp related to defrauding people by sending scanners in the name of old coins/vashikaran puja-path. From above discussion, it is clear that accused petitioners are fully involved in the cyber crime and there is sufficient material against the accused petitioners showing their complicity in the alleged serious offence. This is not a general crime, but a deliberate, serious offence that defrauded ordinary citizens, affecting their lives. This is not a simple case of fraud; it is a white collar economic organized crime related to cyber crime. The present case is related to cyber crime which is a threat to the society and innocent people are suffering huge losses by falling into the trap of such criminals. This is a threat to the public at large. Further, the investigation is at a crucial stage where interrogation is required.

**10.03.2026** Considering the above facts and circumstances, allegation is serious in nature, gravity of offence, allegation against the accused petitioners is direct, investigation is still pending and this case is related to cyber crime, hence at this stage, I am not inclined to enlarge the accused petitioners Sanjeet Kumar and Vibhuti Kumar on regular bail. Consequently, the prayer for regular bail of accused petitioners Sanjeet Kumar and Vibhuti Kumar stands rejected.
