<p><u>Contd....2</u> 24.03.2026</p>	<p>situated in Mouza Nimi, P.S- Sheikhopursarai, District-Sheikhpura (which is a roadside residential Deeh land). The land was purchased from Krishnanandan Singh, S/o Late Gariban Singh, R/o Village Nimi, P.S. Sheikhopursarai, District Sheikhpura, through a Kewala for a sum of Rs. 3 1/2 lakhs (Rupees Three and a half lakhs). The sale deed was executed in the name of the complainant's wife, Smt. Sanju Devi, and his real brother Shishupal Kumar's wife, Smt. Juli Devi. Since the date of purchase, they have been in continuous physical possession of the property and the possession continues to this day. Furthermore, on the basis of this possession and after the verification of the purchased sale deed, the mutation of the property was completed in the names of the buyers and the land revenue receipts have also been issued for the year 2019-20. With the intention of grabbing the complainant's land and for their own wrongful intention, an illegal gang of accused persons namely Balmiki Singh, Vinod Kumar, Rajiv Kumar, Ajay Kumar and Chaitanya Diwakar Dev was formed by the residents of the village-Nimi. All of them colluded under a conspiracy with fraudulent intent to harass and ruin the complainant. For their wrongful financial gain, despite knowing that the complainant had already purchased the said 5 1/4 decimal land of Khasra 3025 from the actual title holder in February 2019 and he is in physical possession of it. The accused persons deliberately, through a conspiracy, obtained a forged sale deed (Kewala) manufactured on 17.05.2019 from a wrong person, Balmiki Singh, who possesses no right, title, or possession over it. Furthermore, the accused persons are criminal elements and land mafia, whose primary occupation and business in the village is to harass simple and innocent people by getting sale deeds executed by unauthorized persons. That the accused persons have executed this very same conspiracy against the complainant, and they are also demanding extortion money from the complainant by stating and threatening to him that, if the complainant does not pay Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten lakhs), they would kill him on that very same land. <p><u>Contd....3</u> 24.03.2026</p>	<p>aware of the forged sale deed manufactured under conspiracy by the accused persons, he formally obtained a certified copy of the alleged sale deed dated 17.05.2019 from the Registry Office, Sheikhpura. The complainant had received the said copy on 22.05.2019 and upon reading it he discovered the details of the forgery done by the accused persons for their wrongful financial gain. Later on, the complainant first went to the Sheikhopursarai Police Station on 23.05.2019 at about 10:00 AM, where he had given his complete statement and requested to register a case. However, the SHO instructed him to file this case at the Sheikhpura Police Station. On 23.05.2019 at about 12:00 PM, he went to Sheikhpura Police Station, where his statement was recorded by the police but the SHO, Sheikhpura has instructed him to file this case in Court. After that, he then went, to S.P. Office and submitted a complaint to him against the accused persons.</p> <p>Ld. Advocate for the petitioners have submitted that the instant case has been falsely registered against the petitioners. The petitioners have not moved any anticipatory or regular bail either before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court and no any other bail petition is pending. It is further submitted that, petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case and there is no specific allegations against the accused petitioners. It is further submitted that accused petitioner no.1 have three previous criminal antecedents bearing Sheikhopursarai P.S. Case No.30/19, Sheikhopursarai P.S. Case No.55/19 and Complaint Case No. 81C/19, the petitioner no.2 has no criminal antecedent against him. The petitioners are ready to abide by the terms and conditions of bail. Hence, prayed to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail.</p> <p>Learned Additional P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail to the accused petitioners.</p>

From perusal it transpires that, this Complaint Case no. 28C of 2019 dated 16.08.2019 has been registered for the offences punishable under Sections 419, 420/34 of the IPC against the accused petitioners. From further persual it appears that, after summoning order, summons to the accused petitioners Balmiki Singh and Rajeev Kumar were issued which were duly served to them. When, after receiving the summons, accused petitioners did not appear before the Court;ailable warrants and non-ailable warrants were issued. The execution report of Non-ailable warrants issued against accused petitioner Rajeev Kumar is also available with the case record. Even after issuance ofailable warrants and non-ailable warrants, accused petitioners didn't appear, the processes under section 82 of the Cr.P.C were also issued against the accused petitioners on 16.01.2026. Despite of every knowledge about the proceedings of the case, accused petitioners didn't appear before the Court and it seems they are avoiding the processes of the Court intentionally.</p> <p>In the circumstances, this Court thinks it not proper to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the accused petitioners.
