28.08.2025 A petition has been filed on 27.08.2025 on behalf of the custody accused-petitioner namely Meera Devi @ Meera Kumari W/o Sahdev Rajak @ Sahdeo Rajak, R/o-Village & P.O Gagri, P.S.- Sirari, District - Sheikhpura has been pressed today. A copy of this bail petition has already been served to the learned Spl. P. P. for the State.

Heard Sri Shyam Kisore Kumar on behalf of the accused-petitioner and Ld. Spl. P.P on behalf of the State.

The learned lawyer for the accused-petitioner submitted that the petitioner has been granted bail by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi vide Criminal Appeal No. 3699/2025 (arising out of SLP (Cri.) No. 9999/2025 dated 28.08.2025. It has further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 28.12.2024 to up till now and she is ready to furnish bail bond. It has been further submitted that the petitioner shall obey the conditions laid down by this court and conditions laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

Learned Spl. P.P. conceded on the submission of learned counsel for the petitioner and submitted that in the light of the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India passed in Criminal Appeal No. 3699/2025 (arising out of SLP (Cri.) No. 9999/2025 dated 28.08.2025, the bail of the petitioner has been allowed.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Spl. P.P for the State and perused the record along with the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court, India passed in Criminal Appeal No. 3699/2025 (arising out of SLP (Cri.) No. 9999/2025 dated 28.08.2025, in which the Hon'ble Supreme Court pleased (for the sake of clarity direction given is extracted herein)

Para 5 The charge sheet which has since been filed upon completion of investigation has

28.08.2025 been perused by us. We are of the considered opinion that further detention of the appellant, who also happens to be a woman, is not required pending trial.

Para 6 Accordingly, we set aside the impugned judgment and order.

Para 7 The appellant shall be released on bail subject to such terms and conditions as may be imposed by the trial court.

Para 8 In the event there is any breach of the terms and conditions for grant of bail, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel the bail of the appellant.

Para 9 It is also ordered that the appellant shall diligently attend proceedings of the trial, unless exempted. If she abstains from attending the proceedings without justifiable cause, that could also be seen as breach of the conditions for grant of bail and the trial court will be free to pass appropriate orders.

Para 10 We clarify that the observations made in this order and grant of bail will not be treated as findings on the merits of the case.

Considering the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India , this court is duty bound to release accused petitioner. Accordingly, in the light of the order dated 25.08.2025 passed by Hon'ble Supreme court of India in Criminal Appeal No. 3699/2025 (arising out of SLP (Cri.) No. 9999/2025, the petitioner namely Meera Devi @ Meera Kumari is directed to be released on bail after furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of this court, with conditions that (1) One of the bailors shall be close relative of the accused petitioner. (2) The petitioner shall physically present in the court till framing of charge. (3) The petitioner will present in court whenever directed by the court to appear in person and will be duly represented through counsel on each and every date of hearing. (4) If the accused-petitioner will not co-operate in trial, her bail bond shall be cancelled. (5) The petitioner shall comply the conditions imposed by Hon'ble Supreme court of India.
