ORDER.

20.04.2026 Bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused petitioner Rahul Yadav **under custody since 25.03.2026** in connection with Sheikhopur Sarai P.S. Case No. 56/2026. The present case has been registered against the accused petitioner and others for committing the offence U/s. 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109(1), 352, 351(2), 303(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. The present petitioner is also named in the FIR with the allegation that he has committed the alleged offence. Hence, he has moved this bail petition U/s. 483 of B.N.S.S.-2023.

As per written report of informant Awadhesh Kumar, prosecution story in brief is that on 23.03.2026, at about 12:00 P.M., Prakash Yadav, a resident of the same village, was verbally abusing the informant's family at Ambari Barki Pokhar. When he objected to this verbal abuse, Mittal Yadav, Rahul Yadav, Priyanka Devi, Manju Devi, and Soni Devi attacked him, his brother Ashok, and his father Ramashish Yadav with Lathi and Danda. During this attack, he and his brother, Ashok Yadav, sustained head injuries, as well as injuries to their hands and feet. Furthermore, his father, Ramashish Yadav, was struck with Lathi on his shoulders, hands, and legs, causing him to fall to the ground in an injured state. Additionally, Prakash Yadav forcibly snatched a gold locket of Lord Hanuman, weighing approximately 5 grams, from his neck. Informant, his brother, and his father somehow managed to flee the scene and succeeded in saving their lives; subsequently, they received medical treatment at the Primary Health Centre in Shekhopur Sarai.

Learned Advocate for the accused petitioner has submitted that accused petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence, rather he has been falsely implicated in this case due to previous enmity. Earlier, the accused petitioner has not filed any bail petition before this Court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The accused petitioner has no criminal antecedent. The

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20.04.2026 petitioner was not present at the place of occurrence nor did he participate in the assault; rather, he has been falsely implicated in this case due to previous enmity. No occurrence occurred with the informant on the alleged date and time. There is a case and counter case between both the parties and Shekhopur Sarai P.S. Case No. 55/2026, which was filed by the petitioner's side against the informant of this case and others. The alleged prosecution case is totally false and concocted. The accused petitioner is in judicial custody since 25.03.2026. Now, the matter has been compromised between both the parties and after compromise both parties do not want to proceed with the case. A joint compromise petition has also been filed along with this bail petition.

Ld. P.P. opposed the bail petition but factum of compromise between the parties is admitted.

Heard the learned Advocate for the accused petitioner as well as Ld. Public Prosecutor and perused the record. From perusal of the case record, it transpires that both parties belong to the same family, and they are Gotiya, and there is a land dispute between them. There is also a case and counter case between both the parties and Sheikhopur Sarai P.S. Case No. 55/2026 has been filed by the petitioner's side against the informant of this case and others. There is general and omnibus allegation against the accused petitioner. Now, both the case and counter case have been compromised between both the parties. The informant of this case, namely Awadhesh Kumar along with injured/victim Ramashish Yadav appeared before the Court, and the injured/victim Ashok Yadav also produced before the Court today from jail custody and stated that they had sustained minor injuries in this incident, and they showed their injuries to the Court, which appeared to have healed. They further stated that the land dispute and the present matter have been amicably settled between both the parties with the intervention of society and after compromise both parties do not want to proceed with the case. In this regard, a compromise petition has also been filed before the Court, which has been duly signed/thumb impression by the informant Awadhesh Kumar and accused petitioner and attested by their respective advocates. As per Para 3 of bail petition of accused petitioner, the accused petitioner has no criminal antecedent and there is no mention about the criminal history of the accused petitioner in the entire record. Further, the accused petitioner is in judicial custody since 25.03.2026. Considering the above facts and circumstances, the present bail petition of accused petitioner Rahul Yadav is hereby allowed and accused petitioner Rahul Yadav be enlarged on bail U/s. 483(2) of B.N.S.S.-2023 on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court, subject to the condition that – **(1). One of the sureties shall be close relative of accused petitioner.**

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20.04.2026 (2). Accused petitioner shall appear before the Ld. Trial Court on each and every dates till framing of the charge.

3. Accused petitioner shall provide his mobile number and Whats App number in writing to the Ld. Trial Court at the time of furnishing bail bond, and shall also undertake not to change his mobile number until the trial is concluded without the permission of the Ld. Trial Court.
