Versus The State of BiharOpposite Party <u>ORDER</u> The present bail application has been filed on behalf of the petitioner, Kanhaiya Kumar, in connection with Sheikhpura P.S. Case No. 65 of 2026 registered under sections 30(a), 32(3) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2018. The petitioner is in custody in this case since 19.03.2026. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the State. Perused the case record. The prosecution case in brief as per the written report of the informant is that, on 18.01.2026 at about 10:05 AM, left the police station for patrol and excise raid along with police personnel. During patrolling, at about 12:30 PM, he received confidential information that a person was transporting country-made liquor in a blue auto (registration no. BR52ER1494) and would proceed towards Makhdumpur Musahari. After informing the superior officer, checking was initiated near the station. At about 12:50 PM, the said auto was intercepted and the driver was stopped. On inquiry, he disclosed his name as Kanhaiya Kumar, aged about 18 years 2 months, son of Anil Yadav, resident of Makhdumpur Musahari, District Sheikhpura. On search of the vehicle, a white-red plastic sack was found concealed in the front storage area. Efforts were made to secure independent

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undergone by the accused petitioner; this Court is inclined to enlarge the accused petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the bail petition filed on behalf of the accused petitioner **Kanhaiya Kumar** is hereby **allowed** and he is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of this Court in connection with the aforesaid case, subject to the following conditions:

1. The petitioner shall not indulge in any similar offence during the pendency of the case.

2. The petitioner shall cooperate with the investigation/trial and shall appear before the Court as and when required.

3. The petitioner is directed to file an undertaking supported with an affidavit that accused petitioner has not more than one criminal antecedents earlier if found previously or in future, his bail bond shall be liable to be cancelled.

In case of violation of any of the above conditions, the prosecution shall be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.
