ORDER

20.04.2026 Anticipatory Bail petition dated 02.04.2026, filed on behalf of the accused/ petitioners 1. Gopal Pandey, 2. Rajiv Pandey @ Rajiv Kumar and 3. Amit Pandey @ Amit Kumar who apprehend their arrest in connection with Karadey P.S Case No. 19/2026, under Sections – 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 110, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. pressed today.

Pressing the bail petition, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that no bail petition either regular or anticipatory have been filed on behalf of the petitioners either before this Sessions Division or before the Hon'ble High Court and the petitioners have no

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criminal antecedent. It has been further submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence and have been falsely implicated in this case. It has been submitted that actually the petitioners were assaulted by the informant for which Karandey P.S. Case No. 18/2026 was lodged and the present case is the counter-blast of the Karandey P.S. Case No. 18/2026. Learned counsel has sought to enlarge the petitioners on the privilege of anticipatory bail.

On the other hand, learned Addl. P.P. has opposed the petition for bail.

Case diary has not been received.

I have heard the submissions and gone through the materials available on the record, it transpires that no other bail petition of any nature is pending on behalf of the petitioners, either before this Sessions Division or before the Hon'ble High Court and petitioners have no criminal antecedent as mentioned in the bail petition. It transpires that the instant FIR has been instituted at the instance of informant Umashankar Vidyarthi alleging therein that on 04.03.2026 at about 02:00 PM his father Shyam Sundar Pandey was returning home after irrigating the wheat crop and heard hulla and went at the place of hulla where he found Amit Pandey was abusing Mangal Murti who objected to the said abuse on which accused Amit Pandey assaulted Mangal Murti by lathi at his head causing injury near the left eye. It is alleged that informant's father tried to pacify the matter, however, accused Gopal Pandey and Rajiv Pandey not only instigated accused Rajendra Pandey and Mahendra Pandey, but also directed them to assault on which the accused assaulted his father by lathi causing injury at the right ear and his father fell on the ground. On which the accused assaulted him by lathi causing injury at his left hand. It is also alleged that accused Shobha, Neha Devi and Kanchan Kumari also assaulted his father and Mangal Murti by bricks and iron rod. The injured Gopal Pandey was taken to Sadar Hospital, Sheikhpura for treatment from where he was referred to Pawapuri Medical College for better treatment.

It appears that the petitioners as well as the informant and injured are present physically and submit that they have compounded the case. The injured informant submits that he did not sustain any major injury rather the injuries were simple in nature. It appears that there is also a counter case which has also been compromised. The FIR has been lodged u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 110, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. and apart from allegation

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u/s 110 of BNS all other allegations are bailable in nature and from the materials available on the record, prima facie no case u/s 110 of BNS is made out against the petitioners. It appears that there was a free fight between the petitioners side and the informant side in which persons from both the sides got injured. Peace has been restored and no public policy is involved. A joint compromise petition duly assigned by the parties and identified by their counsels has also been annexed. The parties are physically present and support the averments made in the joint compromise petition.

Under these circumstances considering the nature of offence and its gravity as well as the general and omnibus allegations against the petitioners, I deem it fit and proper to enlarge the petitioners 1. Gopal Pandey, 2. Rajiv Pandey @ Rajiv Kumar and 3. Amit Pandey @ Amit Kumar on the privilege of anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Id. Trial Court within four weeks from the date of passing of this order on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount subject to the satisfaction of the Id. Trial Court.

The instant anticipatory bail petition dated 02.04.2026 stands **allowed**.
