Vrs The State of BiharOpposite Party <u>ORDER</u> The record has been placed before this Court for order. Instant anticipatory bail petition has been preferred by the petitioners in connection with Sheikhpura PS. Case no. 59 of 2026 dated 07.03.2026, pending before the Ld Court of CJM, Sheikhpura. This record has been received by this Court, vide order dated 13.04.2026, of Ld. Principal District & Sessions Judge, Sheikhpura for hearing and disposal. Heard, Learned Advocate for the petitioners and Md. Taslimuddin, Learned A.P.P. for the State. This Sheikhpura PS. Case no. 59 of 2026 dated 07.03.2026 has been registered for the offences punishable under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 109(1), 303(2), 351(2), 352 and 3(5) of BNS against the accused petitioners. The prosecution case, in brief, as per the written report of the informant is that, on 06.03.2026 at about 06:50, when he was working in his showroom. Accused persons Rohit Kumar @ Kaliya, Vijay Kumar, Pankaj Kumar, Triloki Yadav, Rahul Kumar and Neeraj Kumar alongwith 05 other co-accused persons came there and started shouting and abusing. When the informant forbids them from shouting and abusing and asked them to move from	

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<u>Contd....2</u> 25.04.2026	the entrance gate, accused persons altogether started abusing him and assaulting him. When showroom's owner Ravi Ranjan Kumar after hearing hue and cry of the informant, came there to save him then accused persons started abusing him too and they assaulted over him. Accused Rohit Kumar @ Kaliya assaulted Ravi Ranjan Kumar with butt of a pistol, accused Vijay Kumar assaulted over the back of Ravi Ranjan Kumar with Iron bar, accused Pankaj Kumar assaulted over their head with Danda, accused Triloki Yadav has snatched a gold chain from Ravi Ranjan Kumar's neck and Rahul Kumar has looted Rs. 2,000/- from his pocket and accused Neeraj Kumar threatened to kill him and his family members if they would file a case. Ld. Advocate for the petitioner has submitted that the instant case has been falsely registered against the petitioner. The petitioner has not moved any anticipatory or regular bail either before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court and no any other bail petition is pending. It is further submitted that petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case and there is no specific allegation against the accused petitioner. It is further submitted that accused petitioner has no any criminal antecedent. The petitioner is ready to abide by the terms and conditions of bail. Hence, prayed to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail. Learned Additional P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail to the accused petitioner. Having heard both the sides. Perused the case record. From perusal it transpires that, this Sheikhpura PS. Case no. 59 of 2026 dated 07.03.2026 has been registered for the offences punishable under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 109(1), 303(2), 351(2), 352 and 3(5) of BNS against the accused petitioner. From persual it appears that, the basic allegation against the accused petitioner is that of assaulting over the head, and other body parts and abusing the informant and one Ravi Ranjan Kumar near his showroom with an intention to kill them. Injury report of the injured persons are available with the case record which shows	
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<u>Contd....3</u> 25.04.2026	inury no.1 as lacerated wound over forehead, pain and swelling over right forearm and lacerated wound over left big toe and injury no.2 shows lacerated wound over parital region of hand and many abbressions over other body parts. Further, the accused petitioner is named in FIR and there is direct and specific allegation of assault over the head of the informant with Lathi with an intention to kill him, due to which injured Mukesh Kumar has sustained injuries over his forehead and multiple body organs. From further perusal of the case record it transpires that, vide order dated 01.04.2026, an anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the co-accused persons in this case has already been partly rejected by this Court. Considering the foregoing discussions, where there is direct and specific allegation of assault against the accused petitioner and the seriousness of allegations labelled against him; this Court thinks it not proper to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the accused petitioner. Accordingly, the instant anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the accused petitioners Pankaj Kumar is hereby rejected. (The order is dictated, corrected and signed by me.)
