ORDER

12.06.2026 Bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused petitioner Paramveer Kumar **under custody since 13.05.2026** in connection with Sheikhpura P.S. Case No. 73/2026. The present case has been registered against the accused petitioner and others for committing the offence U/s. 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. The present petitioner is also named in the FIR with the allegation that he has committed the alleged offence. Hence, he has moved this bail petition U/s. 483 of B.N.S.S-2023. Ld. P.P. submitted case diary.

As per written report of informant Duryodhan Kumar, prosecution story in brief is that on 31.03.2026 at about 8:00 P.M., he was returning home after meeting nature's call when accused Dulli Devi abused him and stated him to be an informer of police, which was objected by the informant, on which accused Dulli Devi assaulted him with Danda. In the meantime accused Paramveer Kumar, Raman Kumar, Sujeet Kumar and Karan Kumar came and assaulted him. Accused Karan Kumar assaulted him with iron rod at his back, and accused Paramveer Kumar assaulted him with Katta on his head, causing head injury, and when he tried to flee, accused Sujeet Kumar assaulted him with iron rod at his head, and then he fell on the ground. Thereafter, accused Raman Kumar snatched Rs. 5,000/- from his pocket when he fell on the ground.

Learned Advocate for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence, rather he has been falsely implicated in this case. Earlier, the accused petitioner had filed anticipatory bail vide A.B.P. No. 248/2026, which was withdrawn; thereafter B.P. No. 586/2026 was withdrawn, after that accused petitioner has not filed any bail petition before this Court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The accused petitioner has no criminal antecedent except this aforesaid case Sheikhpura P.S. Case No.

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12.06.2026 71/2026 U/s. 126(2), 116(2), 117(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. According to the prosecution, the occurrence took place with the informant on 31.03.2026, but after a one day delay FIR has been lodged, and the delay has not been explained. The entire prosecution story is totally false and concocted; rather, informant is badly engaged in molesting, and on several occasions he committed and used force to outrage modesty. According to the prosecution case, it is neither believable nor true that a person will go to the bathroom and have taken five thousand rupees. According to the prosecution case, it further appears that neither there was any intention nor any motive to kill the informant. The allegation of assault is totally false; hence, the alleged section 109 of B.N.S. does not make a case against the petitioner, and except for section 109 of B.N.S., other sections are bailable in nature. In fact, the informant has no injury at all, but if he produces any injury report, it will be fake and forged. As per the injury report of the injured, all injuries are simple in nature. Co-accused Sujeet Kumar has been granted regular bail by this Court vide B.P. No. 598/2026 dated 05.06.2026. The accused petitioner is in judicial custody since 13.05.2026. The petitioner undertakes that he shall cooperate in the investigation and shall be present before the Court on every fixed date.

Ld. P.P. opposed the prayer for bail and has submitted that accused petitioner is involved in the alleged occurrence.

Heard Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioner as well as Ld. Public Prosecutor and perused the record. From perusal of case record, it transpires that both parties belong to same village and there is general and omnibus allegation of assault against the accused petitioner. From perusal of case diary, it appears that witnesses of the case diary have also stated in general and omnibus manner. From perusal of injury report, it appears that the doctor has found only one injury on the person of injured informant Duryodhan Kumar i.e. incised wound 1" x 1/2" on skull. Adv.-X-ray of skull AP and lateral view-X-ray of skull AP and lateral view shows report – NAD. Nature of injury – Simple. Kind of weapon used – Hard and blunt substance. From perusal of injury report, it appears that injury of injured is simple and the same is not life-threatening. The injury report of the injured Duruyodhan Kumar shows an incised wound measuring 1"x1/2" on skull and the X-ray of skull does not show any abnormanility. According to the written report of informant, the accused petitioner attacked the informant with a 'Katta', however, the doctor has found an incised wound on

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12.06.2026 the head of the informant which can not be caused by a 'Katta'. From perusal of Para 12 of the case diary, it appears that accused petitioner has one criminal antecedent vide Sheikhpura P.S. Case No. 71/2026 dated 29.03.2026 and the same is mentioned in Para 3 of bail petition of accused petitioner. Co-accused Sujeet Kumar has been granted regular bail by this Court vide B.P. No. 598/2026 dated 05.06.2026, and the case of present petitioner stand on similar footing. Further co-accused persons Dulli Devi, Raman Kumar and Karan Kumar have been granted anticipatory bail by the Court of Ld. D.A.S.J.-II, Sheikhpura vide A.B.P. No. 248/2026 dated 15.05.2026. Furthermore, the accused petitioner is in judicial custody since 13.05.2026. Considering the above facts and circumstances, the present bail petition of accused petitioner Paramveer Kumar is hereby allowed and accused petitioner Paramveer Kumar be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court, subject to the condition that –

1. One of the sureties shall be close relative of accused petitioner.

2. Accused petitioner shall fully cooperate in the investigation and shall appear before the I.O. as and when required.

3. Accused petitioner shall appear before the Ld. Trial Court on each and every dates till framing of the charge.

4. The accused petitioner shall provide his mobile number and Whats App number in writing to the Ld. Trial Court at the time of furnishing bail bond, and shall also undertake not to change his mobile number until the trial is concluded without the permission of the Ld. Trial Court.
