ORDER

20.04.2026 Anticipatory Bail petition dated 18.04.2026, filed on behalf of the accused/ petitioner Mangal Murti who apprehends his arrest in connection with Karandey P.S Case No. 18/2026, under Sections – 126(2), 115(2), 118, 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS pressed today.

Pressing the bail petition, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that no bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been filed on behalf of the petitioner either before this Sessions Division or before the Hon'ble High Court and the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. It has been further submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case. It has further been submitted that the present case is counter-blast of Karandey P.S. Case No. 19/2026 lodged by the petitioner against the informant side. It has also been submitted that from the averments made in the FIR no case u/s 109 of BNS is made out against the petitioner and

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other offences are bailable in nature. Learned counsel has sought to enlarge the petitioner on the privilege of anticipatory bail.

On the other hand, learned Addl. P.P. has opposed the petition for bail.

Case diary has been received.

I have heard the submissions and gone through the materials available on the record, it transpires that no other bail petition of any nature is pending on behalf of the petitioner, either before this Sessions Division or before the Hon'ble High Court and nothing has been mentioned in the case diary with regard to the criminal antecedent of the petitioner. It transpires that the instant FIR has been instituted at the instance of informant Amit Kumar alleging therein that on 04.03.2026 at about 02:00PM he was going through the gali when accused Mangal Murti @ Maccha intercepted him and not only abused him but also scuffled with him which was objected by him on which accused Mangal Murti pushed him on the ground and on hearing hulla, accused Shyam Sundar Pandey being father of the said Mangal Murti @ Maccha brought sawal from his house and handed it over to his son Mangal Murti, who assaulted him by sawal at his head and accused Rajkumari Devi being mother of Mangal Murti @ Maccha assaulted him by bricks at his mouth and in the meantime, Rajmani Pandey came with lathi and assaulted his father at his legs. It is also alleged that Sangita Devi and Suhani Kumari also assaulted him and his family members. On hulla, when passersby came, the accused fled.

Perusal of the case diary shows that the informant has supported his case in his restatement at Para 2 and the witnesses at Para 3 and 4 have also supported the prosecution case. Injury report of injured Amit Pandey shows a lacerated wound over forehead measuring 05 cm X 05 cm X skin deep and abrasion in upper lip. The injury report of injured Gopal Pandey shows that the injured suffered pain and swelling in both legs and ankles and pain and swelling in left arm. The injury report of injured Rajiv Kumar shows pain and swelling in left hand wrist joint. All the injuries were found simple in nature and caused by hard and blunt substance. It appears that the allegations against the petitioner is to have assaulted the informant by sawal at his head. The injury report of the informant, however, does not show any injury at the mouth or face of the informant which makes the allegation of assault at the mouth improbable. From the injuries sustained by the injured prima facie no case u/s 109 of BNS is made out against the petitioner. The petitioner is aged about 40 years

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and the reformation of the petitioner cannot be ruled out. Moreover, there is a counter-case between the parties which shows that both sides assaulted each other and persons from both the sides sustained injuries. A joint compromise petition duly assigned by the parties and identified by their counsels has also been annexed. The parties are physically present and support the averments made in the joint compromise petition.

Under these circumstances considering the nature of offence and its gravity as well as the general and omnibus allegations against the petitioner as also the injuries of the injured, I deem it fit and proper to enlarge the petitioner Mangal Murti, on the privilege of anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Id. Trial Court within four weeks from the date of passing of this order on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount subject to the satisfaction of the Id. Trial Court.

The instant anticipatory bail petition dated 18.04.2026 stands **allowed**.
