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ORDER

26.05.2026 Anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused petitioners Ranveer Kumar @ Ranveer Yadav and Shyam Kumar @ Shyamvriksh Yadav apprehending arrest in connection with Sheikhpura P.S. Case No. 104/2026. The present case has been registered against the accused petitioners and others for committing the offence U/s. 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 76, 109(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. The present petitioners are also named in the FIR with the allegation that they have committed the alleged offence. Hence, they have moved this anticipatory bail petition U/s. 482 of B.N.S.S-2023. Ld. P.P. submitted case diary.

As per written report of informant Pawan Pandit, prosecution story in brief is that on 26.04.2026, a 'Vid Vyavahar' ceremony was underway in connection with the marriage of his nephew, Rohit Kumar. During this ceremony, when everyone reached the vicinity of the government school located in Khorampur, accused Ranvir Kumar, Shyam Kumar, and Subhash Yadav, who were present there, began engaging in obscene acts toward the women. When the families attending the wedding objected to this, the three of them began pulling at and tearing the clothes of the girls and women. Ranvir Kumar threw 14-year-old Nishu Kumari to the ground and repeatedly kicked her in the chest, resulting in a complete fracture to her ribs, while simultaneously hurling verbal abuse. When the people present there tried to protest, all the three accused went into a nearby cattle shed and from there Ranvir Kumar and Shyam Kumar came armed with iron rods and Subhash Yadav armed with Danda, thereafter, they started attacking the people. As a result, several people present there sustained head injuries and broken bones; the women were admitted to the Sadar Hospital, Sheikhpura for treatment, while others received treatment at a private hospital.

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26.05.2026 Learnd Advocate for the petitioners has submitted that petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence, rather they have been falsely implicated in this case. Earlier, the accused petitioners have not filed any bail petition before this Court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The accused petitioners have no criminal antecedent. The FIR of this case has been registered under sections 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 76, 109(1), 352, 351(2), and 3(5) of B.N.S., which are not applicable against the petitioners, as the petitioners have not committed any incident of the kind alleged against the petitioners. The allegations levelled against the petitioners are absolutely false and baseless. The petitioners are law-abiding persons, and they are ready to obey every direction of this Court. Now, the matter has been compromised between both the parties and after compromise both parties do not want to proceed with the case. A joint compromise petition has also been filed along with this anticipatory bail petition.

Ld. P.P. opposed the bail petition but factum of compromise between the parties is admitted. Ld. Advocate for the informant also supported the factum of compromise between the parties.

Heard Ld. Advocate for the petitioners, Ld. Advocate for the informant as well as Ld. Public Prosecutor and perused the record. From perusal of case record, it transpires that both parties belong to same village and the occurrence took place between both the parties over trivial issue of dancing to D.J music at a wedding ceremony. The allegations leveled against the accused petitioners are of a general and omnibus nature. The witnesses of the case diary have also stated in general and omnibus manner. There is contradiction between the written report and the statement of the victim Nishu Kumari. According to the informant's written report, accused Ranveer Kumar threw his daughter Nishu Kumari to the ground and assaulted her. However, victim Nishu Kumari stated in her statement mentioned in Para 7 of the case diary that the accused Shyam and Subhash threw her to the ground and assaulted her. From perusal of the injury report, it appears that only two persons are injured in this case, namely Nishu Kumari and Laxmi Kumari. The doctor has found only two injuries on the person of injured informant Nishu Kumari i.e. (i). Pain in skull region. Adv. CT scan of brain show report - NAD. (ii). Painful swelling left chest Adv.-CT Scan of thorax plan show report- subtle ground glass opacity in the superior segment of left lower lobe. Caused by- Hard and blunt substance. Nature of injury – Simple. The doctor has found only one injury on the person of injured Laxmi Kumari i.e. (i). Bruise on right ear 2" x 2". Adv.- CT scan of brain – show report- Extracalvarial soft tissue swelling involving right periorbital region. Caused by- Hard and blunt substance. Nature of injury –

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26.05.2026 Simple. From perusal of injury reports, it appears that injuries of injured are simple in nature and the same are not life-threatening. Further the matter has been compromised between both the parties. On 16.05.2026, the informant of this case namely Pawan Pandit and victim Nishu Kumari appeared before the Court and stated that they have compromised the matter with all the three accused. They further stated that it was a minor dispute involving no serious allegation. The victim Nishu Kumari further stated that no one had molested her and that the altercation had arisen over dancing to the D.J. music at wedding. After compromise both parties do not want to proceed with the case. In this regard, a joint compromise petition has been filed before the Court, duly signed by the informant Pawan Pandit, victim Nishu Kumari and accused petitioners, and also attested by their respective advocates. From perusal of Para 28 of the case diary, it appears that accused petitioners have no criminal antecedent and the same is mentioned in Para 3 of anticipatory bail petition that accused petitioners have no criminal antecedent. Considering the above facts and circumstances, the present anticipatory bail petition of accused petitioners Ranveer Kumar @ Ranveer Yadav and Shyam Kumar @ Shyamvriksh Yadav is hereby allowed and in the event of arrest or surrender within 15 days from today, accused petitioners Ranveer Kumar @ Ranveer Yadav and Shyam Kumar @ Shyamvriksh Yadav be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court, subject to the condition that – **1.**

One of the sureties shall be close relative of accused petitioners.

2. Accused petitioners shall appear before the Ld. Trial Court on each and every dates till framing of the charge.

3. Accused petitioners shall provide their mobile numbers and Whats App numbers in writing to the Ld. Trial Court at the time of furnishing bail bond, and shall undertake not to change their mobile numbers until the trial is concluded without the permission of the trial court.
