ORDER

09.06.2026 Anticipatory Bail petition dated 18.05.2026, filed on behalf of the accused/ petitioner Sintu Mahto @ Sintu Kumar who apprehends his arrest in connection with Mahila P.S Case No. 530/2024, under Sections- 341, 323, 498A, 506, 504, 494/34 of IPC and 3/4 of D.P. Act pressed today.

Pressing the bail petition, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that no bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been filed or is pending on behalf of the petitioner either before this Sessions Division or before the Hon'ble High Court and the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. It has been further submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case. It has been submitted that co-accused have already been enlarged on bail by the Id. S.D.J.M., Sheikhpura vide its order dated 10.03.2026 and the case of the petitioner stands on similar

footing. It has been submitted that the petitioner has not solemnised his second marriage as alleged by the informant. Learned counsel has sought to enlarge the petitioner on the privilege of anticipatory bail.

On the other hand, learned Addl. P.P. has opposed the petition for bail.

L.C.R. has been received which also contains the case diary.

I have heard the submissions and gone through the materials available on the record, it transpires that no other bail petition of any nature is pending on behalf of the petitioner, either before this Sessions Division or before the Hon'ble High Court and the petitioner does not have any criminal antecedent as revealed from Para 25 of the case diary. It transpires that the instant FIR has been instituted at the instance of informant Rubi Devi alleging therein that she was married to Sintu Mahto as per Hindu Rites and Rituals in July, 2018 and after the marriage she went to her sasural and lived happily and from the said weddlock, she was blessed with two daughters. It is alleged that after the birth of second daughter, her husband along with her devar Pintu Kumar and Sanni Kumar, Mother-in-law Kanti Devi, sister-in-law Soni Devi and father-in-law Jamahir Mahto started demanding Rs. 3 lakhs as dowry and for non-fulfillment of the same, she was subjected to mental and physical cruelty. It is also alleged that the accused used to lock her in a room and did not give her food. It is alleged that her husband solemnised his second marriage with one Kajal Kumari @ Ranju Kumari and when she objected and complaint to the police, the informant was sent to her maika on 25.04.2024. It is further alleged that a panchayati was convened and her husband agreed to take her to sasural, however, on 09.06.2024, the informant was again ousted from her matrimonial home.

Perusal of the case diary shows that the informant has supported her case in her restatement at Para 2 and the witnesses at Para 3 and 9 have also supported the prosecution case. Para 18 of the case diary shows that the petitioner was served with notice u/s 41(1) of Cr.P.C. The witnesses at Para 30 and 31 have also supported the prosecution case. Para 49 of the case diary shows that the petitioner appeared before the police and cooperated in the investigation and was released on furnishing bonds. Para 50 of the case diary shows that the petitioner has admitted to have solemnised his second marriage with one Kajal Kumari @ Ranju Kumari and the said Kajal Kumari @ Ranju Kumari at Para 51 has also admitted to

have married the petitioner. The supervising authority at Para 54 has found the case true against the petitioner. The independent witness at Para 60 has supported the prosecution case. It appears that the investigation is already complete and charge-sheet has already been submitted against the petitioner. The case at hand is fully covered with the judgment passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court titled as (2014) 8 SCC 273 Arnesh Kumar Vs State of Bihar, (2022)10SCC51 titled as Satyendra Kumar Antil Vs CBI and (2023) live law(SC)583 titled as Asfak Alam Vs State of Jharkhand. The petitioner is ready to face trial.

Under these circumstances considering the nature of offence and its gravity, I deem it fit and proper to enlarge the petitioner Sintu Mahto @ Sintu Kumar on the privilege of anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Id. Trial Court within four weeks from the date of passing of this order on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount subject to the satisfaction of the Id. Trial Court.

The instant anticipatory bail petition dated 18.05.2026 stands **allowed**.

Let a copy of this order be transmitted to the Id. Trial Court forthwith.
