**ORDER**

**30.05.2026** Anticipatory Bail petition dated 19.05.2026, filed on behalf of the accused/petitioners 1.Chand Alam and 2. Md. Siraj Alam who apprehend their arrest in connection with Mission P.S Case No. 15/2026, under Sections – 190, 191(2), 126(2), 115(2), 352, 109(1) of BNS and 3(i)(r)(s), 3(2)(va) of SC/ST Act pressed today.

Pressing the bail petition, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that no bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been filed or is pending on behalf of the petitioners either before this Sessions Division or before the Hon'ble High Court and the petitioners do not have any criminal antecedents.. It has been further submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence and have been falsely implicated. It has been submitted that the injury found on the person of injured Ranjan Kumar was found simple in nature and caused by hard and blunt substance. It has further been submitted that the FIR has been instituted u/s 190, 191(2), 126(2), 115(2), 352, 109(1) of BNS and 3(i)(r)(s), 3(2)(va) of SC/ST Act and apart from allegation u/s 109(1) BNS all other allegations of BNS are bailable in nature and no case u/s the

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provisions of SC/ST Act is made out against the petitioners. Learned counsel has sought to enlarge the petitioners on the privilege of anticipatory bail.

On the other hand, learned Spl. P.P. has opposed the petition for bail.

Case diary has been called from ABP 198/2026.

I have heard the submissions and gone through the materials available on the record, it transpires that no other bail petition of any nature is pending on behalf of the petitioners either before this Sessions Division or before the Hon'ble High Court and the petitioners do not have any criminal antecedents as revealed from Para 76 of the case diary. It transpires that the instant FIR has been instituted at the instance of informant Rajveer Kumar alleging therein that on 13.03.2026, his younger brother Ranjan Kumar was using bluetooth when accused Sarfraz Alam @ Sukhroo asked bluetooth from him and abused him on his caste line for using bluetooth. It is alleged that at about 01:00 PM accused Md. Sahil Alam, Chand Alam, Samir Alam, Sarfraz Alam @ Sukhroo, Jamal Alam, four sons of Mohan Alam, Adil, Sheru, Pintu, Seraz Alam, Parvez Alam s/o Riyaz, Shamshad Alam, Parvez Alam s/o Siraj, along with 4-5 unknown assailants while coming from Masjid not only caught hold of him but also abused him on his caste line. It is alleged that when the said Ranjan objected, all the accused pushed him on the ground and Md. Siraj Alam tried to cut his throat by knife. On hulla, when informant and other villagers ran to save Ranjan the accused fled. The injured Ranjan was brought to the hospital of Dr. Murari Babu at Barbigha where Ranjan was given seven stitches at his neck.

Perusal of the case diary shows that the informant has supported its case at Para 2 in his restatement and the witnesses at Para 3 and 8 have also supported the prosecution case. The injured witness at Para 30 has also supported the prosecution case, but has stated that accused Siraj Alam cut his throat by knife. The injury report of the injured Ranjan Paswan shows that the injured sustained a lacerated wound over chin, margin irregular with size 2"x1/4"x skin deep, fresh blood. As per the doctor, the injury was caused by hard and blunt object and the injury was found to be simple in nature. From the FIR itself, it appears that the informant has alleged that his brother Ranjan Kumar was having bluetooth in his ear when all the accused abused him on account of his caste which was objected by informant's brother. It is alleged that all the accused not only abused him, but also pushed him on the ground and accused Siraj Alam cut his throat by knife, however, the doctor has not found any injury on the neck of the injured rather the injury was found on the chin and that too caused by hard and blunt object. The allegations against the Petitioner No. 1 is only to have abused the informant's brother. No other overt act is alleged to have been committed by the Petitioner No. 1. The injury report does not substantiate the allegations leveled by the informant against the Petitioner No. 2. The injured himself has stated in his statement before the police at Para 30 that none of the accused abused him on his caste line. It also appears that there is a counter case between the parties vide Mission P.S. Case No. 16/2026 lodged by the petitioners' side against the informant side. From the materials available on the record, it appears that the allegation against the petitioners are general, omnibus and composite in nature. Co-accused have already been enlarged on the privilege of anticipatory bail by this Court and the case of the petitioners stand on similar footing.

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Under the circumstances, considering the nature of offence and its gravity as well as the fact that the injury report does not substantiate the allegations, I deem it fit and proper to enlarge the petitioners 1. Chand Alam and 2. Md. Siraj Alam on the privilege of anticipatory bail in the event of their surrender or arrest within four weeks from the date of passing of this order on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount subject to the satisfaction of the Id. Trial Court.

The anticipatory bail petition dated 06.04.2026 stands **allowed**.

Let a copy of the order be transmitted to the Id. Trial Court forthwith.
