**ORDER**

**27.05.2026** Bail petition dated 20.05.2026, filed on behalf of the accused/petitioners 1. Jairam Raut, 2. Jaypal Kumar, 3. Dharmpal Kumar and 4. Shishupal Kumar who are in custody since 17.04.2026 in connection with Kasar P.S Case No. 36/2026, under Sections- 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118, 109, 76, 303(2), 329(4), 351(2), 352, (5) of BNS pressed today.

Pressing the bail petition, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that no bail petition has been filed or is pending on behalf of the petitioner either before this Sessions Division or before the Hon'ble High Court and the petitioners have no criminal antecedent. It has been further submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence and have been falsely implicated in this case. It has been submitted that the petitioners are the relatives of the

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informant and petitioners have been implicated in order to grab her property. Learned counsel has sought to enlarge the petitioners on the privilege of bail.

On the other hand, learned Addl. P.P. has opposed the petition for bail.

Case diary has been received.

I have heard the submissions and gone through the materials available on the record, it transpires that no other bail petition of any nature is pending on behalf of the petitioners, either before this Sessions Division or before the Hon'ble High Court and petitioners have no criminal antecedents as revealed from Para 22 of the case diary. It transpires that the instant FIR has been instituted at the instance of informant Neha Devi alleging therein that on 11.04.2026 at about 02:20 PM she was at her house when accused Jairam Raut, Jaypal Kumar, Dharmpal Kumar, Shishupal Kumar and Pancha Devi along with 5-7 unknown assailants armed with lathi, danda and iron rod came at her residence and not only abused her, but also assaulted her husband. It is alleged that when she and her sister-in-law (nanad) Pramila Devi and brother-in-law (devar) Nitish Kumar and Batish Kumar came to save her, all the accused assaulted them by lathi, danda and iron rod causing injury to her husband Sagar Kumar and devar Nitish Kumar and Batish Kumar and her sister-in-law (nanad) Pramila Devi. It is further alleged that accused Jairam Raut and his sons caught hold of her by her hair and pushed her on the ground and also snatched her gold mangal-sutra and gold earrings of her nanad. On hulla, when people gathered, the injured were taken to hospital for treatment from where her husband Sagar Kumar was referred to Pawapuri Medical College from where also he was referred to IGIMS, Patna where he is under treatment.

Perusal of the case diary shows that the informant has supported her case in her restatement at Para 3 and the injured witnesses at Para 4, 5 and 6 have also supported the prosecution case. The supervising authority at Para 26 has also found the occurrence true. From the FIR itself, it appears that the allegation against the petitioners is not only to be a member of unlawful assembly armed with weapons, but also to have assaulted the informant's husband Sagar Kumar and her devar Nitish Kumar and Batish Kumar as well as her nanad Pramila Devi. There is specific allegation of commission of overt act against the petitioners. The petitioners are the main assailants. The supervising authority at Para 26 has found the occurrence true. The injury report of injured Batish Kumar shows fracture at mid shaft of left ulna and the injury report of injured Pramila Devi shows linear undisplaced fracture of roof of left orbit and the injury report of injured. The injuries appear to be grievous in nature and the injury report of injured Sagar Kumar who is battling for his life at IGIMS, Patna is not on the record. It appears that the petitioners armed with lathi, danda and iron rod, not only entered into the house of the informant, but also assaulted her husband and other family mem-

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bers. The FIR has been lodged u/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118, 109, 76, 303(2), 329(4), 351(2), 352, (5) of BNS and from the materials available on the record, prima facie case u/s 109 of BNS cannot be said to be not made out against the petitioners. The case is still at the stage of investigation and charge-sheet has not been submitted.

Under these circumstances considering the nature of offence and its gravity as well as the fact that the petitioners are the main assailant, I do not deem it fit and proper to enlarge the petitioner 1. Jairam Raut, 2. Jaypal Kumar, 3. Dharmpal Kumar and 4. Shishupal Kumar on the privilege of bail at this stage.

Consequently, the instant bail petition dated 20.05.2026 stands **rejected**.

Let a copy of this order be transmitted to the Id. Trial Court forthwith.
