A petitions has also been filed on behalf of accused persons stating that they wants to plead guilty in this case filed under section 37 of Bihar prohibition and Excise (Amendment) Act, 2022 as F.I.R was lodged against him u/s 37(b) of Bihar Excise Amendment Act, 2016 and Charge has been framed against the same accused u/s 37(b) of Bihar prohibition and excise act, 2016.
 Heard the defence lawyer as well as learned A.P.P.

As per notification of the Government of Bihar on April 28, 2022, the Bihar Prohibition and Excise (Amendment) Rules, 2022 has been passed to further amend the Bihar Prohibition And Excise Act, 2016. Under this amendment, a provision has been made to release accused after he pays a fine from two thousand rupees upto five thousand rupees, if he is caught while drinking u/s 37 of Bihar Prohibition and Excise (Amendment) Act, 2018 read with rule 18 of Bihar Prohibition and Excise (Amendment) Rule, 2022.

The petition accepted the charge and he ready to deposit the fine. So, he is sentenced to pay a sum two thousand rupee and in default of payment of the fine, accused is awarded to undergo one month imprisonment.
