ORDER

06.06.2026 Bail petition dated 26.05.2026, filed on behalf of the incarcerated accused Sandeep Kumar, who is in custody since 28.04.2026 in connection with Cyber P.S Case No. 20/2026, under Sections 319(2), 318(4), 318(2), 338, 336(3), 340(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. r/w Sec. 66c/66d of IT Act, 2000 pressed today.

Pressing the bail petition, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that no bail petition of any nature is pending on behalf of the petitioner either before this Sessions Division or before the Hon'ble High Court and the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. It has been submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case. It has further been submitted that nothing incriminating has been recovered and seized from the possession of the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner has sought to enlarge the petitioner on the privilege of bail.

Cyber P.S Case No. 20/2026 Dated- 06.06.2026 Addl. S.J.Ist, Sheikhpura

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Ld. Addl. P.P. as well as Ld. Counsel for the informant have opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

L.C.R. and case diary have been received.

I have heard the submissions and gone through the materials available on the record, it transpires that no bail petition of any nature is pending on behalf of the petitioner either before this Sessions Division or before the Hon'ble Court and the petitioner has a criminal antecedent as revealed from Para 56 of the case diary. It transpires that the instant FIR has been instituted at the instance of informant P.I. Saket Saurav, Cyber P.S., Sheikhpura alleging therein that on 28.04.2026 at about 07:30 AM, the S.D.P.O., Cyber Crime, Sheikhpura passed the information that towards West of railway line at Nasratpur, some people had gathered and were indulged in cyber fraud. At the direction of S.D.P.O., a raiding team was constituted and the team after crossing Nasratpur railway line reached balwapar Badhar at about 12:20 PM and saw 8-10 people having mobile in their hands were busy in doing something and as soon as they saw the police, all the assailants tried to flee, however, three assailants were apprehended by the police and 6-7 assailants managed to flee. The apprehended assailants disclosed their names as Rakesh Kumar Yadav, Sandip Kumar and Siti Kumar. The apprehended assailants were searched in presence of an independent witness Bablu Kumar and police witness Anshu Kumar after giving their search to these witnesses. It is alleged that from the possession of accused Rakesh Kumar Yadav, a sky blue colour Oppo Mobile and from possession accused Siti Kumar an Oppo Company purple colour mobile and a Vivo Company cream colour mobile were recovered. It is further alleged that from the possession of Siti Kumar, six ATM Cards issued by Fino Payment Bank and one NSDL Payment Bank ATM Card were recovered. It is alleged that from the place of occurrence, 11 mobiles of different company and two power banks were also recovered. The apprehended accused could not answer the recovery of mobiles and ATM Cards as such a seizure list was prepared and a copy of the same was handed over to the apprehended assailants. The accused were brought to P.S. and the seized mobiles were examined. It appears that Vivo Company cream colour mobile was registered in the name of Akbar Ali of Nagaon City, Asam and the blue colour Vivo Company mobile was registered in the name of one Ganesh Kumar Jha of House No. 12B/5 Sidhgora Cross Road No. 7, Agrico, Jamshedpur, Jharkhand. From the seized mobile several QR Codes, screen shots of several Aadhar Cards and list of persons were recovered. The accused could not answer as to why and how he got ATM Cards and mobiles were in

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their possessions. The accused were formally arrested after institution of the Cyber P.S. Case No. 20/2026.

Persual of the case diary, shows that the informant has supported his case in his restatement at Para 06 and the witness at Para 10 has also supported the prosecution case. The seizure list witnesses at Para 35 and 36 have also supported the prosecution case. The supervising authority at Para 37 has also found the case true against the petitioner. From perusal of the case diary, it appears that from the possession of accused Rakesh Kumar Yadav, a sky blue colour Oppo Mobile and from possession accused Siti Kumar an Oppo Company purple colour moblie and a Vivo Company cream colour mobile were recovered. It is further transpires that from the possession of Siti Kumar, six ATM Cards issued by Fino Payment Bank and one NSDL Payment Bank ATM Card were recovered. It further transpires that from the place of occurrence, 11 mobiles of different company and two power banks were also recovered. The apprehended accused could not answer the recovery of mobiles and ATM Cards as such a seizure list was prepared and a copy of the same was handed over to the apprehended assailants. The accused were brought to P.S. and the seized mobiles were examined. It appears that Vivo Company cream colour mobile was registered in the name of Akbar Ali of Nagaon City, Asam and the blue colour Vivo Company mobile was registered in the name of one Ganesh Kumar Jha of House No. 12B/5 Sidhgora Cross Road No. 7, Agrico, Jamshedpur, Jharkhand. From the seized mobile several QR Codes, screen shots of several Aadhar Cards and list of persons were recovered. The accused could not answer as to why and how he got ATM Cards and mobiles were in their possessions. It appears that the recovery of such large number of ATM Cards belonging to the persons unknown to the petitioner along with mobiles registered in the name of person unknown to the petitioner were recovered and seized. The mobiles belong to one Akbar Ali and Ganesh Kumar Jha who were not known to the petitioner. The SDR of the mobiles show that various numbers of teachers apart from several QR Codes and unknown numbers were found in the mobiles of the petitioner. The petitioner could not produce any document pertaining to the mobile or the other seized articles from the place of occurrence which prima facie shows that involvement of the petitioner in the alleged offences. The FIR has been instituted u/s 319(2), 318(4), 318(2), 338, 336(3), 340(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. r/w Sec. 66c/66d of IT Act, 2000 and the maximum punishment prescribed for the alleged offences are up to ten years imprisonment. The case is still at the stage of investigation and charge-sheet has not been submitted. The apprehension of tampering of evidences and witnesses cannot be ruled out.

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Under such circumstances, considering the nature of offence and its gravity as well as the role of the petitioner in committing the alleged offence, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner Rakesh Kumar Yadav on the privilege of bail.

Consequently, the bail petition dated 26.05.2026 stands **rejected**.

Let a copy of the order be transmitted the Learned Trial Court forthwith.
