

State Vs Vinod Kumar CHI 22 2022

Present: Sh. Prince Dhanjal, APP for the State

Non bailable warrants of accused received back with the report that accused was informed telephonically. Case called several times since morning but accused has not appeared in the court. Therefore, this court is satisfied that accused is knowingly evading the service and intentionally is not appearing in the present case. So, proclamation under Section 84 of BNSS against the accused be issued, requiring the accused to appear in the court on 14.11.2024.

The serving constable is directed to publish/execute the proclamation as under:-

1. It shall be publicly read in some conspicuous place of the town or village in which the accused ordinarily resides;
2. It shall be affixed to some conspicuous part of the house homestead in which the accused ordinarily resides or to some conspicuous place of such town or village.
3. A copy of thereof shall be affixed to some conspicuous part of the court-house.

The serving constable is further directed to effect the proclamation on or before 11.10.2024 and to appear on 11.10.2024 for recording his statement regarding the due compliance of the orders of the Court, failing which action as per law shall be taken against him.
