This anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf on the accused petitioner Dharmveer @ Neta @ Dharmveer Kumar who apprehending his arrest in connection with Taraiya P.S. case No.- 320/2024, registered u/s 341, 323, 325, 307, 379, 504, 506/34 of B.N.S pending in the court of Ld. A.C.J.M-XIII, Saran. Copy of the petition has been served to the learned P.P..</p> <p>2. The case of the prosecution in nut-shell as per written application of the informant, Manoj Kumar Singh is that on 30.06.2024 at about 08:30 A.M., as soon as the informant reached near Rambag Canal, two men suddenly hit his bike and he fell down. It is alleged that both the men started molesting him, when he protested, on man showed gun at him and the other man started hitting him with an iron rod with the intention of killing him, they also took his purse having Rs. 7500/- and the gold chain from his neck. The local people told Dharmveer @ Neta to leave the informant otherwise the informant would die, and some unknown people were also with him, all of them fled towards Khatanti road. It is also alleged that the informant was seriously injured due the beating by them and further he went for treatment.</p> <p>3. The learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner submitted that earlier no B.P. or A.B.P on behalf of the accused petitioner has ever been filed or moved either in any court of law. It is further submitted that the petitioner has been implicated in this case at the instance of his enemies. The police is searching for the petitioner to arrest him. That the petitioner undertakes to abide by all the conditions laid down u/s 482 of BNSS. Hence, he prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.</p> <p>4. Learned PP opposes the bail petition vehemently.</p> <p>5. Heard learned counsel on behalf of the accused petitioner and Learned P.P. for the state, perused the record and case diary along with L.C.R. On perusal of case diary Para 23, the injuries received by the injured/informant Manoj Kumar singh is reported normal and simple in nature. There is no criminal antecedent of the accused petitioner on the record.</p>
