01	7.3.2026	<p>Heard learned counsel for petitioner as well as learned P.P. for the State on anticipatory bail petition of petitioner namely Deepak Kumar who is apprehending his arrest in the above referred case registered u/s 137(2), 87 of I.P.C.</p> <p>FIR of this case has been registered on the basis of written application of the informant Parmila Devi 28.12.2025 at about 10 O'clock her daughter namely Anjal Kumari aged about 18 years had gone out of house to attend call of nature. But she did not return as yet. It is further alleged that this petitioner has abducted the victim on allurement. The mobile of the petitioner was switched off.</p> <p>It is submitted on behalf of learned counsel for petitioner that he is innocent, he has not committed any offence and has been falsely implicated in this case due to suspicion, victim girl is major and she has been recovered and her statement u/s 183 of BNSS has been recorded in which she has not stated any thing against the petitioner, no any regular or anticipatory bail petition has been filed by the petitioner in any Court of law, petitioner has got clean antecedent, and he is ready to furnish sureties as required by the Court. Therefore, it is prayed that the petitioner may be enlarged on anticipatory bail.</p> <p>The learned P.P. opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.</p> <p>Perused materials available on record and from perusal of the same, it is found that the petitioner is named in the FIR that he has abducted the victim. Victim has been recovered and her statement u/s 183 of BNSS has been recorded in which she stated nothing against the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he has got no criminal antecedent. At para no. 3 of the bail petition it has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that he has got no criminal antecedent.</p> <p>Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, I think it proper to enlarge accused petitioner on</p>	

	<p>anticipatory bail. Accordingly, in the event of his arrest or surrender within two weeks from the date of receipt of this order, he is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned subject to condition laid down u/s 482(3) of BNSS with further condition that</p> <p>(I) the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by I.O. as and when required,</p> <p>(II) that the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to the I.O. of the case.</p> <p>(II) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court</p> <p>(IV) petitioner is directed to co-operate in trial and disposal of the case.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">[Dictated]</p> <p style="text-align: center;">I/C Sessions Judge, Saran.</p>
