This anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf on the accused petitioner namely Pankaj Kumar, S/o Bhola Ray who apprehending his arrest in connection with Garkha P.S. case No.-995/2025, registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2) 117(3), 118(2), 119(2), 324(6), 109(1), 303(2), 3(5) of B.N.S pending in the court of Sri Anup Rawat, J.M. 1st Class, Saran. Copy of the petition has been served to the learned P.P..</p> <p>2. The case of the prosecution in nut-shell as per written application of the informant Sanjay Rai is that on 27.12.2025 at about 02:30 P.M., the informant was going to Doriganj from his home with rupees one lac to purchase four new tyres for his Truck. As soon as he reached near Jigna Village situated at Garkha Chirand road, suddenly all the accused persons namely 1. Chunnu kumar, 2. Munna Ray, 3. Guddu Kumar, 4. Vinay Ray and 5. Pankaj Kumar (Petitioner) altogether assaulted upon the informant. It is also alleged that Munna Ray, Guddu Ray and Vinay Ray damaged the informant’s motorcycle by hitting on it. It is further alleged that according to conspiracy, the accused petitioner Chunnu Ray tried to hit the informant on his head by means of iron rod which was protected by his right hand, due to which informant’s right had got injured. Chunnu Kumar and Pankaj Kumar assaulted the informant on his leg by the country made ‘Katta’ and snatched rupees one lac form the possession of him..</p> <p>3. The learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. That earlier, no B.P. or A.B.P has ever been filed or moved either in this court or in the Hon’ble High court, Patna. It is further submitted that the Petitioners have no criminal antecedent. That the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case due to previous enmity, dirty village politics and more over due to take undue advantage. It is further submitted that the charges against the petitioners are totally false, baseless and concocted. That as a matter of fact, no occurrence has ever taken place as alleged by the prosecution, the fact is that the informant sustained leg injury in a motorcycle accident due to previous enmity. He managed the police and got the instant case registered. It is also submitted that the petitioner is ready to abide by all the conditions imposed upon him. That the accused</p>

Learned PP opposes the bail petition vehemently.</p> <p>5. Heard learned counsel on behalf of the accused petitioners and Learned P.P. for the state, perused the record and case diary. On perusal of C.D. Para 47 and 56, the injuries received by the victim is on his right hand and leg fractured. There is general and omnibus allegation against the accused petitioner. There is no criminal antecedent against the accused petitioners on the record and investigation is still pending against him.</p> <p>6.
