Heard learned counsel representing the petitioner-accused as well as learned Public Prosecutor representing the State on bail petition of petitioner-accused, namely, <b>Kundan Kumar Ray</b>, who has been in custody since 03.02.2026 in this Mashrakh P.S. Case No. 40/2026, registered under Sections 137(2) and 96 of BNS, pending in the Court of learned ACJM- 7<sup>th</sup>, Saran at Chapra.</p> <p>2. FIR of this case has been registered on the basis of a typed application of the informant, namely, <i>Sandhya Devi (Victim's mother)</i> stating that on 25.01.2026 at about 07:00 P.M., her 16-years-old daughter, namely, <i>Guriya Kumari</i>, went to attend nature's call. The informant also went after her daughter and she saw that the petitioner-accused abducted her daughter with intention of marriage. The petitioner-accused made the informant's daughter sit on his motorcycle and fled away.</p> <p>3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner-accused submitted that he is quite innocent and has not committed any offence as alleged in the F.I.R. Next asserted that that earlier no ABP or regular bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner-accused in this Court or Hon'ble High Court, Patna in connection with the present case, and he got clean antecedent except this one. The petitioner-accused has been in custody since 03.02.2026. Next added that the informant has filed this totally false and concocted case against the petitioner-accused only on suspicion due to village enmity and dirty politics. Next added that the victim girl, namely, <i>Guriya Kumari</i> has been recovered by the police and her statement u/s 183 of BNSS has also been recorded in which she denied the allegations against the petitioner-accused. Next contended that according to victim's statement u/s 183 of BNSS, no case of 137(2) &amp; 96 of BNS is made out. Further submitted that the petitioner-accused is ready to furnish sureties as required by the Court. Therefore, it is prayed that the petitioner-accused may be enlarged on Bail.</p> <p>4. On the other hand, learned Public Prosecutor representing the State vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner-accused.</p> |         |

|  | <p>5. Heard both the sides and perused the materials available on record. From the record, the allegation is that the petitioner-accused abducted the informant's daughter with intention to marry her. However, the victim girl, namely, <i>Guriya Kumari</i> has been recovered by the Police, and her statement u/s 183 of B.N.S.S. has also been recorded in which she did not support the prosecution case at all, and denied the allegation of her kidnapping.</p> <p>6. So, considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, the victim's categorical statement, period of custody undergone by the petitioner-accused, absence of criminal antecedent, and the reasons mentioned herein-above, <b>I</b> think it proper to release the petitioner-accused on bail and thereby this <b>Bail Petition</b>, bearing <b>No. 330 of 2026</b> is hereby <b>allowed</b>.</p> <p>7. Accordingly, the petitioner-accused herein, namely, <b>Kundan Kumar Ray</b>, is ordered to be <b>released</b> on bail on furnishing bail bond of <b>Rs. 50,000/-</b> <u>with two sureties</u> of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court concerned subject to the condition laid down u/s 480(3) of B.N.S.S. :-</p> <p>(I) That the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by I.O. as and when required,</p> <p>(II) That the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to the I.O. of the case,</p> <p>(III) That the petitioner shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court,</p> <p>(IV) That the petitioner is directed to co-operate in trial and disposal of the case.</p> <p>[Dictated]</p> <p><b>(Puneet Kumar Garg),</b><br/>Sessions Judge, Saran<br/>24.03.2026</p> |  |
