**ORDER**

1. **This regular bail petition has been filed on the behalf of aforesaid petitioner who is in judicial custody since 06-02-26 in** connection with Amnaur P.S. case No. 41/26 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 117(2), 109(1), 74, 329, 352, 351(2), 3(5) BNS. Heard learned counsel for the both sides and perused the record.
2. **Prosecution case in brief** as based upon written report of Saroj Devi is that on 06-03-26 at 10:30 AM her neighbour Ramanand Ram came at her house under influence of alcohol and started abusing. Upon protest, he along with co-accused Akash Kumar, Vikash Kumar, Nisha Kumari, Mithilesh Kumar, Krishna Ram and Bachchi Devi variously armed with lathi, iron-rod, axe came and started abusing and assaulting. Accused Ramanand Ram gave lathi blow upon husband of informant namely Ram Bahadur Ram resulting bone fracture. Informant's sister-in-law Anita Kumari was assaulted with iron-rod on her head by petitioner/accused Akash Kumar. It is claimed that accused persons assaulted with intention to kill and their life was saved by neighbour intervention.
3. **Ld Counsel for petitioner stated that they are quite innocent** and falsely implicated as both sides are neighbours and case and counter case was filed between both sides. In fact present case has been filed by informant to save their skin from earlier case Amnaur P.S. Case 42/26 filed by petitioner family member Bachchi Devi. There is general and omnibus allegation and injury report does not support prosecution case. Lastly, it is claimed that both sides entered into mutual settlement and compromise.
4. **On the contrary Ld. A.P.P. appearing on behalf** of the state vehemently opposed the bail petition but fairly conceded about mutual compromise between both sides.
5. **Heard Learned counsels for both sides and perused entire record.** There is case and counter case between both sides over previous land dispute. Today informant Saroj Devi

physically appeared before this court and admitted about mutual settlement and compromise pursuant to Panchayati. She disclosed that minor scuffle took place and nobody got seriously injured. Both sides are neighbours.

6. Therefore, having regard to aforesaid facts and circumstances and considering mutual settlement and period of custody, **petitioner Akash Kumar is granted regular bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs 10,000/-** of two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. court below.
