30.03.2026	1. This anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf on the accused petitioners namely 1. Amit Rai & 2. Prabhawati Devi who apprehending their arrest in connection with Amnour P.S. Case No.-370/2025, registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109(1), 329(3), 303(2), 352, 351(3)/3(5) of B.N.S pending in the court of M/s Ratna Kumari, J.M. 1st Class. Copy of the petition has been served to the learned P.P.. 2. The case of the prosecution in nut-shell as per written application of the informant, Prabhunath Rai is that on 16.12.2025 at around 10:00 A.M, the informant was walking towards north direction. At that time, Amit Rai was coming at a high speed on his a motorcycle bearing reg. no. BR04 AU 3355. He stopped near the informant, the informant got scared and tried to run away from there and asked why he was riding so, then 1. Amit Rai, 2. Mohan Rai and 3. Mohan Rai's wife and three (03) unknown persons, all of them together with sticks and iron rods in their hands came to the informant's door suddenly. Mohan Rai abused and assaulted upon the informant with iron rod in his hand with intention to kill him, due to which he got injuries on his head, bleeding started and he fell to the ground. Thereafter, informant's wife, Anita Devi came for intervention, then they started hitting her too. Amit Rai took Mangalsutra, made of gold from the neck of the informant's wife and he threatened that if the informant filed any case, then he would kill him. 3. The learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence, they have been falsely implicated due to Amnour P.S. Case no.-371/2025. Earlier, no B.P. or A.B.P on behalf of the petitioners has been filed before this court or Hon'ble High Court, Patna. It is further submitted that the Petitioners have no criminal antecedent. That there are the case and counter case between the parties vide Amnour P.S case no. 370/25 & 371/25. It is further submitted that the main accused person, Mohan Rai is on bail vide B.P. No.- 94/26. That the petitioner are ready to furnish the bail bond and obey any terms and conditions imposed upon them. Hence, he prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.	cont.

On the other hand, learned Public Prosecutor representing the state vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the accused petitioners. 5. Heard learned counsel on behalf of the accused petitioners and Ld. P.P. for the state, perused the record and case diary. On perusal of C.D. Para 45, according to the supplementary injury report, the injuries got by the informant/victim is reported as 'simple in nature' and as per para 26 of the C.D, the injuries received by Anita Devi is also reported as 'simple in nature'. There is no criminal antecedent against the accused petitioners on the record. Investigation regarding this case is still pending. 6. In facts and circumstances deliberated above, learned court below is directed to admit the bail for the petitioners namely Amit Rai & Prabhawati Devi on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10000/- with two solvent sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of learned court below, if they surrender before it within a period of 30 days from the date of this order subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of Cr.PC.
