This anticipatory bail petition is filed on behalf of accused namely, 1. Bablu Singh @ Madan Singh, 2. Mukul Kumar, 3. Amarjeet Ojha, in connection with Awatarnagar P.S case No. 101/26 registered under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 303(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) B.N.S.

Ld. Advocate on behalf of the accused petitioner submits that accused petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. It is prayed to enlarge the accused petitioner on bail.

Learned Additional P.P opposed the bail of the petitioner.

Heard both parties. In brief, this prosecution case is registered on the basis of written petition of informant namely, Ram Vinod Upadhyay, wherein, it is stated that on 04/03/2026, at around, 11:30 AM, all accused persons namely, Ranjan Kumar Singh, Raunak Singh, Mukul Kumar Singh, Bablu Singh @ Madan Singh, Amarjit Ojha, came armed with axe, iron rod & other weapons and accused Ranjan Kumar Singh & Raushan Kumar Singh assaulted the informant with axe & iron rod on head with intention to kill, thereby, fracturing the informant's head & blood oozed out. When informant's son namely Abhiraj Upadhyay came to rescue, accused Amarjit Ojha caught him & on order of Amarjit Ojha, accused Mukul Singh & Raunak Singh assaulted informant's son with bricks, axe, thereby, fracturing his head also. Later on, accused persons also snatched golden chain from the informant's neck & later on absconded. The informant & his son were treated at P.H.C Dighwara & later on referred to Sadar Hospital Chapra. Accordingly, this case is registered under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 303(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) B.N.S.

With respect to accused Mukul kumar, From perusal of para 4 of case diary containing re-statement of informant & para 5 of case diary containing statement of injured & para 6, 22, 24, 25 of case diary containing statement of other witnesses, it transpires that there is direct & specific allegation of assault on accused Mukul Kumar to have assaulted the informant's son with bricks & axe, thereby, fracturing his head. From perusal of para 28 of case diary containing injury report of injured Abhiraj Upadhyay, it transpires that three injuries have been caused including lacerated wound on the left corner of the parietal region as the patient was sent for C.T. Scan of brain to Sadar Hospital, Chapra. The case is under investigation. Considering direct & specific allegation of assault on vital part of the body, coupled with the injury, and also for reasons mentioned above, I am not inclined to release the accused petitioner, on anticipatory bail. **Accordingly, the anticipatory bail of accused petitioner namely, Mukul Kumar, is hereby rejected.**

With respect to other accused namely, Bablu Singh @ Madan Singh & Amarjeet Ojha, From perusal of the record containing case diary, it transpires that there is general & omnibus allegation on accused Bablu Singh @ Madan Singh. Allegation against Amarjeet Ojha is to have caught the injured & to be order giver. From perusal of para 22, 24 of case diary, it transpires that the witnesses have stated accused Amarjeet Ojha to be only the person involved in intervening between the parties. As per para 3 of the bail petition, accused petitioners do not have any criminal antecedent.

Considering the fact that there is general & omnibus allegation of assault on both accused, and also for reasons mentioned above, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the
