ORDER

1. **Aforesaid 07 petitioners are apprehending arrest in** connection with Parsa P.S. case No. 55/26 registered U/s **126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 352, 351(2) (3), 3(5) BNS. Heard learned counsel for the both sides and perused the record.**
2. **Prosecution case in brief as based upon written report of informant** Akshay kumar is that on 08/2/26 during weeding procession of her cousin, a group of local unruly persons played caste based vulgar songs and when asked to stop, they physically assaulted family members and further threatened to kill on next day. On following day 09/02/26 around 3 PM when no male members were present, FIR named 10 accused persons including petitioners attacked informants house and cracked his mother Kaku devi head,broke aunty Lilawati devi hand and grandfather leg. When informant arrived at P.O he was also assaulted . All accused persons were variously armed with fighter, bat, chain ,iron rod.
3. **Ld Counsel for petitioner stated that they are quite innocent** and falsely implicated in present case as due to previous enmity. There is no specific allegation against any of petitioners and all sections areailable except Section 109 BNS which is not applicable. In fact, earlier co-accused mother filed i.e. Parsa P.S. Case No.56/25 against informant side due to which present case has been filed. All injured received simple nature of injury and

petitioners have clean criminal antecedent. Moreover, similarly situated co-accused Amarjeet Kumar was granted regular bail vide BP No. 301/26 dt 16-03-26.

4. **On the contrary Ld. A.P.P, appearing on behalf** of the state vehemently opposed the bail petition and stated that FIR named all accused including petitioners in furtherance of common intention abused and assaulted informant and him family members.
5. **Heard Learned counsels for both sides and perused entire record.** Dispute occurred over minor issue of playing of casteist and vulgar songs during marriage procession resulting in fight and filing of case and counter case. There is general and omnibus allegation against 10 accused persons without any specific allegation of any overt against petitioners. From perusal of injury report of injured, it appears that injured sustained simple nature of injury except one fracture injury on toe of Gugali devi opined Grievous in nature. Similarly situated co-accused Amarjeet Kumar was granted regular bail by this Court by BP No. 301/26 dt. 16-03-26.
6. Therefore, having regard to aforesaid facts and circumstances **aforesaid petitioners namely 1. Golu Kumar, 2. Munna Kumar, 3. Bipin Kumar,4. Nitesh Kumar, 5. Jitendra Kumar,6. Dinkar Kumar, 7. Shrawan Kumar are directed to be released on anticipatory bail** in the event of their surrender or arrest by police within a period of 04 weeks from the date of receipt of this order upon furnishing of bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount subject to satisfaction of Ld Court below.
