Heard learned counsel representing the petitioner-accused and learned Public Prosecutor representing the State.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner-accused has submitted that the petitioner-accused was granted anticipatory bail by the Court of learned DASJ-II, Saran in Cyber P.S. Case No. 322/2025, titled as *Anil Kumar V/s State of Bihar vide Order dated 30.03.2026 passed in ABP No. 3872/2025 in which one month time was given to the petitioner-accused to surrender before the learned Court concerned and furnish bail bonds. However, the petitioner-accused, owing to getting a private job in a construction company in Calcutta and due to refusal of granting leave by the said company on the ground of newly appointment, could not surrender before the learned Court concerned and furnish bail bonds in time as per the Order of the Court of learned DASJ-II, Saran dated 30.03.2026. Now, the petitioner-accused is fully willing and ready to surrender before the concerned Court at the earliest opportunity, but the stipulated period has expired. In such circumstances, the petitioner-accused may be given some time for the above purpose.*

Learned Public Prosecutor representing the State has got no objection.

After hearing and considering the submissions so made by learned counsel for the petitioner-accused, it appears that the petitioner-accused, namely, **Anil Kumar**, due to the reasons as mentioned herein-above, could not comply with the Order of the Court of learned DASJ-II, Saran dated 30.03.2026. So, in the above facts and circumstances of the case and in the interest of justice, the petitioner-accused is given **ten days' time from the date of this Order** to surrender before the learned Court concerned and furnish the bail bonds on payment of cost of Rs. 1,000/- in Nazarat/DLSA, Saran.

Accordingly, this **Criminal Misc. Petition**, bearing No. 103 of 2026, dated 04.06.2026, stands **disposed of as allowed.**
