Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Addl. P.P. for the State on bail petition of petitioner namely 1. Abhimanyu Singh who is in custody since 20.6.2026 in the above referred case registered u/s 126(2), 116(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 76, 352, 351(2))3) 3(5) 3(5) of BNS.

Brief case of prosecution is that Kamlawati is informant of this case and on 18.6.2024 at about 11.45 O'clock of noon, this petitioner and other three accused persons named in the FIR were cutting soil from the field of the informant, to which the informant and her husband raised objection, on this, the petitioner and other accused persons of this case having lathi, danda and iron rod started assaulting the informant and her husband. Accused Rajnish Singh tried to outrage the modesty of the informant. Some other accused persons taken part in the occurrence and started assaulting to the informant side. Injured persons of this case taken to hospital for treatment.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that they are innocent and they have not committed any offence and have been falsely implicated in this case due to suspicion, there is case and counter case between the parties, there is omnibus allegation against the petitioner that he along with other accused persons of this case assaulted the informant and others, no any regular or anticipatory bail petition has been filed by the petitioner in any court of law, he is named accused in one another case, he is in custody since 20. 6.2026 and he is ready to furnish sureties as required by the Court. Therefore, it is prayed that the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

The learned Addl. P.P. opposed the prayer for bail.

Perused the record and on perusal of the same, it is found that there is general and omnibus allegation against the accused persons that they have assaulted the informant and her husband with lathi, danda and iron rod. Allegation of molesting is against accused Rajnish Kumar. Two persons have received injury in this case and on perusal of the injury reports, it is noted that the doctor has opined the injuries of both the injured as simple in nature caused by hard and blunt substance. At para no. 22 of the case diary, it has been reported by the concerned P.S. is not named accused in any other case in the P.S. concerned. Further more the petitioner is in custody since 20.6.2026.

Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case and period of custody, and also for the reasons mentioned above, I am inclined to enlarge accused

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petitioner on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court concerned subject to condition laid down u/s 480(2) of BNSS.

(I) the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by I.O. as and when required,

(II) that the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to the I.O. of the case.

(II) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court

(IV) petitioner is directed to co-operate in trial and disposal of the case.

(V) one of the bailor must be the close relative of the petitioner.
