This anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf on the accused petitioner namely <b>Vishal Singh, S/o Satendra Singh</b> who apprehending his arrest in connection with Daudpur P.S. case No.-131/2025, registered u/s 334(1), 303(2), 324(4) of B.N.S. pending in the court of Sri Pradeep Kumar, J.M. 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Saran. Copy of the petition has been served to the learned P.P..</p> <p>2. Prosecution case in brief is that according to the written application of the informant, Srinivash Kumar Paswan is that On 29.05.2025, both the informant and Ajay Kumar Prasad went to their house after closing their shops. He further alleged that at about 12:00 AM accused persons namely 1. Vishal Singh, 2. Appu Singh, 3. Vipul Singh along with 10-15 unknown persons broken his shop by JCB and Rs 5,000/-were taken out from the shop of medical store and Rs 8,000/- were take out from the shop of grocery. He further alleged that at the mean time, Paroling Vehicle was passing on, then all persons fled away and one person caught by the police and without number plate JCB seized by Chassis No.- HAR3DX55KO-2603519K and one black coloured Apache motorcycle bearing reg. no. BR04AU-9993 seized in this case. The informant have suffered a loss of about Rs. 8 to 10 lacs due to vandalism and theft of his shop.</p> <p>3. The learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has not committed any offence as alleged in the F.I.R. That earlier to this case, no B.P. or A.B.P has ever been filed or moved either in this court or in the Hon'ble High court, Patna. It is further submitted that the Petitioners have no criminal antecedent and he has been falsely implicated in this case due to local village political vendetta. That the petitioner is neither arrested on the spot nor any incriminating article or any of stolen article has been recovered from his conscious possession. It is further submitted that there is no specific allegation against the accused petitioner and the person arrested on the spot with black coloured Apache motorcycle has been granted bail. That the petitioner is man of means having no chance of his absconding or tempering with prosecution evidence. It is also submitted that the petitioner is ready to abide the order of the court and to co-operate the concerned police in investigation. Hence, he prayed to enlarge the petitioners on bail.</p>

On perusal of Case diary, Para 45 and 50, it transpires that there is land dispute between the parties and the land was purchased by the accused petitioner from one Munni Devi in year 2023. As per para 78, there is no criminal antecedent of the accused petitioner.</p> <p>6.
