Ld. Counsels for accused submits that accused is in JC since 18.01.2026 and has been falsely implicated in the present case. Thus, it is prayed that accused be granted bail.

Ld. APP has opposed the bail application on the ground that if accused is enlarged on bail, he may commit similar type of offence and threaten/influence the prosecution witnesses/victim.

Arguments heard and record perused.

Accused is in JC since 18.01.2026, Further, accused is no more required for the purpose of custodial interrogation and no purpose would be served by keeping the accused behind bars. In the present facts and circumstances, accused is admitted to bail on furnishing of personal bond in the sum of Rs. 20,000/- with one surety in the like amount subject to following condition:-

1. The applicant will not tamper with the evidence during the trial.

2. The applicant will not pressurize/ intimidate the prosecution witnesses.
3. The applicant will appear before the trial court on the date fixed, unless personal presence is exempted.
4. The applicant shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected.

The copy of this order be given dasti to the counsel of the accused and also sent to accused through concerned Jail Superintendent for necessary information immediately.

Nothing expressed in the said order shall be construed as expression of opinion of the Court on the merits of the case.

Application stands disposed off accordingly.
