<u>11.08.2026.</u>	This bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely, Atal Rai who is in custody since 20.05.2026 in connection with Suppi PS Case No. 11/26 registered u/ss: 317(4),317(5) BNS. 2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned I/C PP for the State. 3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is quite innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. All the allegations levelled against the petitioner are false and baseless. Name of the petitioner has been disclosed by co-accused Lakhinder Kumar who has already been granted bail vide BP No. 110/26 order dated 10.2.2026. The petitioner has criminal antecedents of two cases. On these grounds, the learned counsel prayed for grant of bail to the petitioner. 4. On the other hand, the learned I/C PP opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that the petitioner is named in the FIR. The police have submitted charge-sheet against the petitioner u/ss: 317(5),317(2) BNS. 5. The prosecution case, in short, as per written application of the informant namely, ASI Vikash Kumar of Suppi PS is that on 8.1.2026 while the informant with other police forces were	

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<u>Contd.</u> <u>11.08.2026.</u>	on evening patrolling duty, at 19.15 hours when they reached near Jamla Bandh, two motorcycles speedily came from Rusulpur side and on seeing police forces the bike borne persons started fleeing away. One bike borne person was apprehended and another managed to flee. The apprehended accused disclosed his name as Lakhinder Kumar and disclosed the name of person who fled as Atal Rai. The apprehended person could not produce valid paper of motorcycle and disclosed that they were going for selling the motorcycle to the liquor businessman. 6. Perusal of record shows that the petitioner was not arrested from the spot. Name of the petitioner has been disclosed by apprehended accused Lakhinder Kumar, who has already been granted bail by the learned predecessor vide BP No. 110/26 order dated 10.2.2026. Investigation of the case is complete and charge-sheet has already been filed. 7. Considering the aforesaid facts & circumstances of the case, prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed and he is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate where the case is presently pending subject to the conditions as laid down u/s: 480(3) BNSS.
