22.04.2026.	<p>This bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely, Rajiv Kumar @ Bholu who is in custody since 29.07.2025 in connection with Runnisaipur PS Case No. 118/24 registered u/s: 394 of IPC.</p> <p>2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this on the confessional statement of the co-accused Abhishek Sahi, who is on bail vide B.P. No. 1431/2024 order dated 05.02.2025. Nothing incriminating material has been recovered from possession of the petitioner. No TIP was conducted in this case. The petitioner has criminal antecedent of 4 cases. On these grounds, the learned counsel prayed for grant of bail to the petitioner.</p> <p>3. The learned I/C PP submitted that although the petitioner is not named in the FIR, but his name surfaced in confessional statement of other co-accused. Baligarh More and Kathi bridge, the Apache bike borne persons overtook and assaulted him with plank studded with nails and pushed him. As a result of which informant's son and pillion rider fell from motorcycle. They saved their life by running away. Assailants took kada, cash of passbook and motorcycle.

5. Heard both sides and perused the record.

6. Perusal of record shows that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. There is no recovery of any incriminating article from his possession. Name of this petitioner surfaced in this case in the confessional statement of co-accused. No TIP has been conducted in the case. Charge-sheet has already been filed. The petitioner is in custody since 29.07.2025.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts & circumstances of the case, bail of the petitioner is allowed. The petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court where the case is presently pending further subject to the conditions as laid down u/s: 480(3) BNSS.
