ORDER

1 Heard, learned counsel for the petitioner, **Raghu Kumar**, who is in custody since 29.04.2025, in connection with Sitamarhi P.S. Case No. 20/2025, registered u/s. 309(4) of B.N.S., 2023. Also heard the learned Addl. P.P. for the State and perused the record and the case-diary.

2. There is allegation in the F.I.R. that the informant Kamlesh Kumar is working as Field Officer in Swatantra Microphin Pvt. Ltd., Sitamarhi Branch and on 02.01.2025 he held meeting of collection of six groups and he alongwith his companion Sunil Kumar after collecting cash Rs. 1,10,094/- was going towards Branch on motorcycle. It is alleged that on the way, three unknown boys came on a bike and pulled his bag as a result of which he fell down and on the point of gun, they snatched away his bag containing cash Rs. 1,10,094/-, Demand Sheet, Mobile Charger and loan cards.

3. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he is innocent and has committed no offence. No other bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner either before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna earlier. The petitioner **has six criminal antecedent**. He has been falsely implicated in this case due to local politics. His name figured in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Raju Kumar in connection with Sitamarhi P.S. Case No. 256/2025. Charge-sheet has also been submitted against the petitioner and other co-accused persons in this case. Lastly, prayer has been made to grant bail to the petitioner.

4. On the other hand, learned Addl. P.P. opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

5. From perusal of the F.I.R. it appears that from Para 53 Sub-Para 9 of the C.D co-accused Raju Kumar was arrested by the police in another case and he confessed before the police and in his confessional statement he accepted his complicity and the complicity of the petitioner in the alleged occurrence. It also appears from the record that nothing incriminating has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. Petitioner is in custody since, 29.04.2025.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the submissions of the learned counsels of the parties, the period of detention of the accused/petitioner in custody and the fact that charge-sheet has been submitted

in the case and investigation is complete, let the petitioner, above-named be released on bail, after framing of charge. onfurnishing bail bond of Rs. 15,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court, subject to the conditions as laid down u/s. 480(3) of B.N.S.S., 2023.
