

**In the Court of the District & Addl. Sessions Judge I, Sitamarhi.
Bail Petition No. 187/2026**

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ORDER

1 Heard, learned counsel for the petitioner, **Raghu Kumar**, who is in custody since 29.04.2025, in connection with Sitamarhi P.S. Case No. 40/2025, registered u/s. 309 of B.N.S., 2023. Also heard the learned Addl. P.P. for the State and perused the record and the case-diary.

2. There is allegation in the F.I.R. that the informant Rakesh Kumar is working as C.O. in B.S.S. Microfinance, Bariyarpur and on 10.01.2025 at about 6.30 P.M., he was going on his motorcycle to deposit collected money Rs. 80,000/- in Airtel point situated behind Bariyarpur Govt. School. It is alleged that on the way, three unknown boys came on a motorcycle from behind and pushed the informant as a result of which he fell down and thereafter, they snatched away cash Rs. 80,000/-, Adhar card, PAN card, A.T.M. card, Adhar Card of his wife and cash Rs. 500/- on the point of pistol and fled away. All the miscreants covered their faces.

3. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he is innocent and has committed no offence. No other bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner either before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna earlier. **The petitioner is also an accused in six other cases.** The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. nor any incriminating article has been recovered from his possession. He has been falsely implicated in this case due to dirty vilalge politics. In fact, some dispute was going on in between the petitioner and co-accused Raghu Kumar and Raghu Kumar threatened to ruin him and so he named the petitioner as liner in his confessional statement. Lastly, prayer has been made to grant bail to the petitioner.

4. On the other hand, learned Addl. P.P. opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

5. From perusal of the F.I.R. it appears that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. but during the course of investigation, co-accused **Sonu Kumar** was granted bail earlier from this court on 01.08.2025. It also appears from the record that nothing incriminating has been recovered from the possession of the

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petitioner. The record further shows that after investigation, charge-sheet has been submitted in the case against the petitioner and others and investigation is complete. The petitioner is in custody since 29.04.2025.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the submissions of the learned counsels of the parties, the period of detention of the accused/petitioner in custody and the fact that charge-sheet has been submitted in the case. Let the petitioner, above-named be released on bail, after framing of charge, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 15,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court, subject to the furnishing of the conditions as laid down u/s. 480(3) of B.N.S.S., 2023.
