1 This bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely, **Pintu Das @ Pintu Kumar** who is in **custody since 05.02.2026** in connection with Nanpur PS Case No. 168/25 registered u/ss: 25(1-b)a, 26/35 Arms Act. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned PP for the State.

3. The prosecution case, in short, as per written application of the informant namely, PSI Sandesh Kumar of Nanpur PS is that on 28.3.2025 at 21.40 hours while the informant with other police forces were on evening patrolling duty, 5-6 boys who were standing at lonely place and on seeing the police forces they started fleeing away. Out of them three persons namely, Sunil Kumar, AwinashKumar and Vivek Kumar were apprehended and on search in presence of witnesses a countrymade pistol was recovered from possession of accused Sunil Kumar, a sword and mobile was recovered from possession of accused Awinash Kumar. Seizure list was prepared and FIR was drawn accordingly.

4. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has no any criminal antecedent and he is quite innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. All the allegations levelled against the petitioner are false and baseless. The petitioner is in custody since 05.02.2026. On these grounds, the learned counsel prayed to release the petitioner on bail.

5. On the other hand, the learned PP has opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Perused the record, name of the petitioner has been disclosed by co-accused Sunil Paswan in his confessional statement. Nothing has been recovered from possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is in **custody since 05.02.2026**.

9. Considering the aforesaid facts & circumstances of the case, period of custody, prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed**. The petitioner is directed to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail-bonds in the sum of *****Rs. 15,000/- (Fifteen Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate where the case is presently pending further subject to the conditions as laid down u/s. 480(3) BNSS.
