1. Heard the learned counsel, for the petitioner, **Abhishek Kumar**, who is in **custody since 16.01.2026**, in connection with Dumra Police Station Case No. 445/2025 registered Under Section 303(2) B.N.S. Also heard the learned Addl. P.P. for the State and perused the record.

2. Prosecution Story in brief:-That the prosecution case is based on the written application of informant Ajay Paswan submitted to the SHO, Dumra, stating that he parked his white coloured Hero Glamour motorcycle at the court premises at about 10:45 A.M. after locking the handle and went to attend his work. At about 5:30 P.M., after finishing his work, when he returned to take his motorcycle, he found it missing. Despite making a diligent search, the motorcycle could not be traced. He has reported that his motorcycle bearing Registration No. BR30X7750, Chassis No. MBLJAW103KKGH22708 and Engine No. JA06ERKKGH21963 was stolen by some unknown person.

3. It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the name of the petitioner does not find place in the F.I.R. The petitioner is in judicial **custody since 16.01.2026**. It is further submitted that no incriminating article (motorcycle) has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The allegation against the petitioner is general in nature and he has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is also submitted that the petitioner is ready to furnish bail bonds and undertakes to cooperate in the trial.

4. Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the period of custody of the petitioner, and materials available on record, let the petitioner **Abhishek Kumar** be released on bail **after framing of charge** in connection with Dumra P.S. Case No. 445/2025, on furnishing bail bond of ₹15,000/- (Fifteen Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below, Sitamarhi, subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 480(3) of the B.N.S.S.
