1 Heard the learned counsel, for the petitioner, **Vishwas Kumar @ Munak**, who is in custody since, 13.02.2026, in connection with Nanpur P.S. Case No. 10/2026, registered u/s. 331(4), 305 & 112(2) B.N.S. Also heard the learned Addl. P.P. for the State and perused the record.

2. Prosecution Story; She hereby state that she, Aashmin Khatoon, wife of Md. Irfan Ansari, resident of village Medinipur, Ward-03, Panchayat Pandil Buzurg. P.S. Nanpur, District Sitamarhi, state that on 11.01.2026 at about 03:00 a.m., when she had gone to her in-laws' house at Furwaria, some unknown persons broke the lock of her house and committed theft of jewellery kept for her and her daughter's wedding, including gold flower, gold nose ring, two pairs of silver anklets, silver mehndi ring, chhapka, tankha, samse ban vicheti, chanar necklace, etc. The total value of the stolen articles is approximately Rs. 3,00,000 to 3,50,000.

3. It is submitted on behalf of the applicant that the applicant is not named in the F.I.R. and his name has transpired only in the confessional statement of co-accused. The petitioner has two criminal history. It is further submitted that no incriminating article or stolen property has been recovered from the conscious possession of the applicant and there is no direct evidence connecting the applicant with the alleged occurrence.

4. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, particularly co accused granted bail earlier and his case is similar footing of that accused. His implication is based on confessional statement and there is no recovery from his possession, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the applicant.

6. Accordingly, let the applicant Princeraj **Vishwas Kumar @ Munak**, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 15,000/- (Fifteen Thousand) with two (02) sureties of the like amount each to the
