1. Heard, learned counsel for the petitioner, **1. Seraj Alam @ Mohd. Seraj Alam 2. Mohd. Imran @ Mohd. Ibran Qureshi, 3. Mohammad Noorain, 4. Mohd. Noor Alam @ Noor Alam, 5. Mahmuda Khatoon**, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Sitamarhi P.S. Case No. 55/2026, registered Under Sections – Under Sections– 126(2), 115(2), 351(2), 352, 117(2), 110, 3(5) B.N.S.. Also heard the learned Addl. P.P. for the State, the learned counsel for the informant.

2. Prosecution Story: As per the prosecution case, the informant alleged that on the night of 21.01.2026, the applicants assaulted her and her sons by means of iron rod causing injuries and also demanded Rs. 5,00,000/- and threatened to dispossess her from the land in dispute. On the basis of the written report of the informant, the present case has been instituted.

3. Submission on behalf of the Applicants:- Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the applicants are innocent and have falsely been implicated due to land dispute between the parties. It is further submitted that there is case and counter-case between the parties, as applicant no. 4 has also lodged Sitamarhi P.S. Case No. 56/2026 against the informant side regarding the same occurrence. It is also submitted that the injury report does not disclose the nature of injury and there are no specific and definite allegations against the applicants. It is further submitted that C.D. has been received at the time of hearing and the applicants have no criminal antecedent except minor dispute of applicant no. 5 which has already been settled.

4. Submission on behalf of the State:-Learned A.P.P. opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

5. Consideration:- Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, particularly that C.D. has been received at the time of hearing, no specific allegation has been attributed against the applicants, nature of injury has not been mentioned in the injury report, and there appears to be case and counter-case arising out of land dispute, this Court is inclined to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the applicants.

6. Accordingly, it is directed that **1. Seraj Alam @ Mohd. Seraj Alam**
