09.06.2026	1. This bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely, Sheikh Molim, in connection with Bairgania P.S. Case No. 58/26 registered u/ss: 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 109, 351(2), 352, 3(5) BNS. 2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner the learned PP I/C for the State and the learned counsel for the informant. 3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in the case. All the allegations levelled against the petitioner are false and baseless. Petitioner in judicial custody since 26.02.2026. No incriminating article was recovered from the possession of petitioner. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Upon these grounds, the learned counsel prays for grant of bail to the petitioner. 4. On the other hand, learned I/C PP and the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the informant opposed the prayer for bail of the

petitioner and submitted that although informant's son sustained stab injury but his injuries are simple in nature and charge-sheet has already been submitted in this case.

5. The case of prosecution, in short, as per written application of the informant namely, Nabi Ahmad Khan is that on 22.2.2026 at 07:00 PM, the FIR named accused persons and four unknown persons armed with sharp weapons intercepted his son Kushbuddin Khan and started abusing him. Afsar Alam, Satender Kumar and Sheikh Mohammad Reja inflicted knife blows to his son. When Sohail Khan went to save him he was also assaulted by fats, fists and slaps. The son of the informant was brought to Sadar hospital, Sitamarhi from where he was referred to SKMCH Muzaffarpur, but due to critical condition he was admitted to the clinic of Dr. Varun Kumar. The cause of occurrence was that his son had gone to masjid for Tarabi namaj and he laughed at some boys who incorrectly read the namaj.

6. Perusal of record shows that in FIR there is general allegation against the petitioner and other co-accused that they abused and co-accused Afsar Alam, Satender Kumar and Sheikh Mohammad Reja stabbed informant's son. However, during investigation witnesses have stated that petitioner and other co-accused stabbed informant's son with knife. As per injury report, nature of injuries of informant's son are simple. Investigation of case is complete and charge-sheet has already filed. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 26.2.2026.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts & circumstances of the case, the bail of the petitioner is allowed. The petitioner is directed to be released
