1. Heard, learned counsel for the petitioner, **Shashi Kumar**, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Bajpatti P.S. Case No. 156/2022, registered Sections: 188, 341, 427, 353, 504/34 IPC. Also heard the learned Addl. P.P. for the State, the learned counsel for the informant.
2. The FIR has been registered against the petitioner/accused and other co-accused persons on the basis of written application dated 3.6.2022 of the victim-cum-informant namely, Devendra Kumar alleging therein, in brief, is that on 2.6.2022 petitioner/accused alongwith other co-accused persons named in the FIR obstructed the police forces in discharging their official duty on account
3. It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner and his name appears only in a general and omnibus manner. It has also been submitted that co-accused persons have already been granted anticipatory bail by the competent court. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent and undertakes to cooperate with the investigation and trial.
4. Learned APP opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.
5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the nature of accusation, absence of specific overt act attributed to the petitioner, the fact that similarly situated co-accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail, and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I am inclined to allow the prayer for anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the petitioner, namely **Shashi Kumar**, shall be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned, subject to the conditions

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prescribed under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
