ORDER

1. Heard the learned counsel, for the petitioner, **Bigu Paswan**, who is in custody since, **12.05.2026**, in connection with Parihar P.S. Case No. 286/2024, registered for the alleged offences Under Sections 127(1), 121(1), 121(2), 132, 296, 3/5 BNS. Also heard the learned Addl. P.P. for the State and perused the record.

2. The prosecution case, in brief, is that on 19.09.2024 at about 5:00 P.M., while the informant, a Sub-Inspector of Police posted at Parihar Police Station, was engaged in maintaining law and order during the immersion procession of Vishwakarma Puja idols, the organizers and participants were directed to immediately immerse the idol in accordance with the conditions of the procession licence. It is alleged that certain persons participating in the procession became aggressive, misbehaved with the police personnel, pushed and obstructed them from discharging their official duties and thereby created a law and order situation. The petitioner is one of the named accused persons in the FIR.

3. It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that the petitioner **has no criminal antecedent** and is in judicial **custody since 12.05.2026**. It is also submitted that the petitioner was not apprehended at the place of occurrence, that no specific overt act has been attributed to him, and that several co-accused persons have already been granted anticipatory/regular bail by the competent court. It is further submitted that the petitioner undertakes to cooperate with the trial and abide by any condition imposed by this Court.

4. Considering the nature of accusation, the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, absence of any criminal antecedent, the fact that co-accused persons have been granted bail, and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court is inclined to allow the prayer for bail.

5. Accordingly, the petitioner, namely **Bigu Paswan**, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned in connection with Parihar P.S. Case No. 286 of 2024, The petitioner shall file an undertaking that neither he nor any group

under his influence shall play any obscene, vulgar, illicit or prohibited songs in any public procession or programme and shall comply with all lawful directions issued by the administration and police authorities and subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 480(3) of the B.N.S.S.
