Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 745/2026

ORDER.

1. Heard the learned counsel, for the petitioner **Priyanshu Kumar @ Monti**, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Parihar P.S. Case No. 286/2024, registered u/s. 127(1),121(1),121(2),132,296,3(5) of B.N.S. 2023. Heard the learned counsels for the petitioners and the learned Addl. P.P. for the State and perused the record and the case-diary.
2. There is allegation in the F.I.R. that on 19.09.2024 while the informant alongwith other police forces were on duty on the occasion of immersion of idol of Vishwakarma, the accused persons were dancing with indecent songs which was protested by the informant and the informant told them to immerse the idol at once, they started mis-behaving and scuffled with the police force and they caused hinderance in discharging their official duty. The petitioners and others were identified among the members of the unlawful assembly.
3. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that they are innocent and have committed no offence. No other anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner either before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna earlier. The petitioner Rohan Kumar has no criminal antecedent while the petitioner Ram Pravesh Kumar is also an accused in Excise Case. They have been falsely implicated in this case due to dirty village politics. The petitioners have no concern with the alleged occurrence. There is no specific allegation against the petitioners. Some other co-accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail and regular bail by this court and the case of the petitioners stand on similar footing. Lastly, prayer has been made to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
4. The learned Addl. P.P. opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners.
5. From the F.I.R., it appears that during the course of emersion of Vishwakarma idol, the persons present in the procession were playing indecent songs and they do not follow the direction of the authorities. On the direction of the informant to emerse the idol at once, they started misbehave and scuffled

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with the police force and they caused hinderance in the Govt. work. The petitioner and others were identified among the members of the unlawful assembly. It also appears that there is no any specific allegation against the petitioner. Simply, they have been identified as member of the unlawful assembly and from the F.I.R. it also appears that no harm has been caused to the police force. It also appears from the record that co-accused persons have been allowed bail vide B.P.No. 1322/2024, B.P.No. 42/2025 and B.P.No. 290/2025 , ABP No 493/2025 and some of the accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail by this court vide A.B.P.No. 1928/2024 and 2123/2024.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, submissions of the learned counsels of both parties, nature of offence and allegation against the petitioner and the fact that the co-accused has been granted regular and anticipatory bail by this court and the case of the petitioner stand on similar footing, I find that this is a fit case for anticipatory bail. Hence, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner **Priyanshu Kumar @ Monti**, is hereby **allowed**. He is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 20,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned lower court, subject to the conditions as laid down u/s. 482(2) of B.N.S.S.
