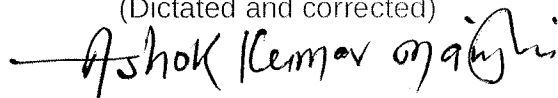
A petition has been filed on behalf of petitioners/accused to withdraw the anticipatory bail petition.
