06.08.2026	Apprehending arrest, this anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely, 1. Baliulla Ansari @ Guddu Ansari, in connection with Kanhauli P.S. Case No. 82/2026 registered u/ss: 25(1-B)a, 26 Arms Act. 2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned I/C PP for the State. 3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is quite innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. All the allegations levelled against the petitioner is false and baseless. There is no recovery of any incriminating article from the vehicle owned by petitioner. Petitioner is having one criminal antecedent. On these grounds, the learned counsel prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. 4. On the other hand, the learned I/C PP opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail. Learned I/C PP further submitted that petitioner ran away after seeing the police, firearm and live cartridges were recovered from the vehicle parked by petitioner. Verification of ownership of vehicle is still pending. The investigation is also pending in the case. The petitioner has two

criminal antecedents and he has concealed his one criminal antecedent in para 3 of the bail petition.

5. The prosecution case, in short, as per written application of the informant namely, ASI Varun Kumar is that on 24.05.2026 at 11:15 hours, during special patrolling duty with police team, they got secret information that Baliulla Ansari @ Guddu Ansari was coming from Majorganj on his vehicle GRAND-10 bearing registration no. BR-06-AZ-8305 with illegal weapons. They tried to catch him on the way but he escaped. During the patrol at 13:05 hours, patrolling team found a vehicle parked but Baliulla Ansari had escaped from there. On search of vehicle, one double barrel desi katta, two live cartridges were recovered. Local people told that vehicle and recovered articles belonged to Baliulla Ansari. Seizure list of desi katta, live cartridges and vehicle was prepared. Accordingly, on the written application of informant, FIR was filed.

6. As per prosecution's case, allegation against petitioner is that he was carrying arms and ammunitions in vehicle Grand-10, BR-06-AZ-8305 and he escaped after parking the said vehicle. During investigation, in paras 8, 9, 10 and 11 of the case diary, informant in his further statement and other witnesses have supported the allegation against petitioner. The petitioner is having two criminal antecedents as per para 33 of the case diary, however, in para 3 of the bail petition, petitioner has disclosed his only one criminal antecedent and he has concealed his one criminal antecedent. The investigation of the case is still pending.

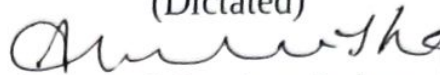
7. Considering the aforesaid facts & circumstances of the case, serious nature of

allegation against petitioner and concealment of one criminal antecedent by petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, his prayer for anticipatory bail is hereby rejected.
