<u>18.07.2026.</u>	Apprehending arrest, this anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely, Seraj @ Md.Seraj in connection with Bhutahi PS Case No. 118/26 registered u/ss: 308(4),308(5),351(2),351(3),3(5) BNS, 25(I-b)a,26/35 Arms Act and 21(b)/22 NDPS Act. 2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the learned I/C Special PP for the State and the learned counsel for the Informant. 3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. All the allegations levelled against the petitioner are false and baseless. Nothing incriminating material has been recovered from possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent. On these grounds, the learned counsel prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. 4. On the other hand, the learned I/C Special PP for the State and the learned counsel for the informant opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail and submitted that the petitioner is named in the FIR. There is direct allegation against the petitioner that he alongwith other two bike borne miscreants came at petrol pump and demanded rangdari of Rs. Two lakhs from the informant and or else threatened to shoot him. The petrol pump	

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else threatened to kill him. Name of the petitioner has been disclosed by the apprehended co-accused persons. There is also recovery of 4 bottles codeine based cough syrup each of 100 ml, total 400 ml from the motorcycle from which the petitioner and other miscreants had gone to the petrol pump. As per paras 27 and 28 of the case diary, the petitioner was identified by witness as one of miscreants involved in the incident. The investigation of the case is still going on.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts & circumstances of the case, nature of allegation against the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, his prayer for anticipatory bail is hereby rejected.
