Joint statement of AR of plaintiff and attorney holder
of defendants no.3 & 4, is recorded separately. In view of
statement given by AR of plaintiff, suit is dismissed qua
defendants no.3 & 4.

Though defendants no.1 and 5 have been shown to be
served through e-mail and WhatsApp. However, there is no
clarity as to how given e-mail ID and WhatsApp numbers were
peculiar to defendants no.1 and 5. Affidavit filed by Mr. Mayank
Mangla refers to the given mobile numbers and e-mail ID as
pertaining to defendants i.e. all the defendants. Mr. Mangla is not
in condition to explain the source of given e-mail ID and mobile
numbers. He seeks time to go through the record to explain the
source. He shall do so on next date of hearing.

On next date, argument shall be heard on application
of defendant no.2 for condonation of delay in filing WS. Put up
on 26.09.2025.
