<u>18.07.2026.</u>	Apprehending arrest, this anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioners namely, 1. Raja Rai @ Rajababu Rai, 2. Munna Kumar @ Munna Rai, 3. Subodh Rai in connection with Pupri P.S. Case No. 122/26 registered u/ss: 126(2), 115(2), 76, 303(2), 351(2), 3(5) BNS. 2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned I/C PP for the State. 3. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case. All the allegations levelled against the petitioners are false and baseless. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent. On these grounds, the learned counsel prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. 4. On the other hand, the learned I/C PP opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail but fairly admitted that there is no specific allegation against these petitioners. 5. The prosecution case, in short, as per written application of the informant namely, Radha Devi is that on 30.4.2026 at about 3.00 PM, Subodh Rai, Mukesh Rai Roshan Kumar, Munna Rai, Rajaram Rai and 8-10 others, in intoxicated condition came near her and making obscene gesture, asked her to accompany them. On objection of informant, they abused and assaulted	

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her. Roshan Kumar gave iron bala blow on her head and caused injury. They also tore her blouse with ill intention and took her gold mangal sutra worth Rs. 85,000/-.

6. Perusal of record shows that there is general and vague allegation against the petitioners that they abused and assaulted the informant. As per injury report of informant, her only injury is simple in nature, which is attributed to accused Roshan Kumar. During investigation of case, the witnesses in para- 4 and 5 of the case diary have only stated that on account of some reason, petitioners and co-accused abused and assaulted the informant. As per para-3 of bail petition, the petitioners have no criminal antecedents.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts & circumstances of the case, anticipatory bail of the petitioners is hereby allowed and in the event of their arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate where the case is presently pending subject to the conditions as laid down u/s: 482(2) BNSS.
