ORDER.

1. The applicant, **Mohd. Hasan Raine**, apprehends his arrest in connection with Bela P.S. Case No. 179/2023 registered under Sections 406, 409, 420/34 of the Indian Penal Code.
2. Prosecution Story:-That the informant, Panchayat Secretary Jayanarayan Prasad Sah of Village Dhanaha, P.S. Bela, District Sitamarhi, submitted a written application to the Officer-in-Charge, Bela Police Station, in reference to Letter No. 490 dated 12.07.2023. In the application, it was stated on the basis of the representation of the Technical Assistant of Gram Panchayat Raj Balaha, Ward No. 17, that the Tap Water Scheme for Every Household under the Chief Minister's Rural Drinking Water Nishchay Yojana, initiated in 1990 by the then Ward Implementation and Management Committee, still remains incomplete. It was further alleged that the then Ward Member Indrajit Mukhiya, father of Ram Sanjeev Mukhiya, and Ward Secretary Mohammad Hasan Rain, father of Ismail Rain, deliberately obstructed the government scheme and illegally withdrew funds before completion of the work, thereby causing loss to government funds.
3. It is submitted on behalf of the applicant that he is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case due to local political rivalry. It is further submitted that the applicant has no criminal antecedent and the work relating to the scheme has substantially been completed, and the applicant undertakes to complete the remaining work, if any, within six months and to submit the completion certificate before the concerned authority. It is also submitted that the applicant is a permanent resident of the locality and there is no likelihood of his absconding or tampering with the evidence.
3. Learned counsel for the State opposed the prayer of the bail of the petitioners.
4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, gone through the M.B Book filed by the petitioner, and account statements of bank, there is no clear cut mentioning of when the said work started and not clear is the year of work, which work was to be completed, what amount of work is to be done and what amount of work has left to be done is not clear and one thing is also not clear that when this work

order was handed over and what was the deadline to complete the work is also not clear. The year of allotment of work has not been mentioned. The petitioner has admitted about completion of Rs. 13 lac worth work.

Rest, he submitted that he will complete the work if directed. This, Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail in favour of the petitioner **Mohd. Hasan Raine**, will be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of ₹15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each, subject to the following conditions that the applicant shall complete the remaining work, if any, within six months and submit the completion certificate of the work before the competent authority within the said period, subject to the conditions as laid down u/s. 482(2) of the B.N.S.S.
