

	29/08/2018	<p>This case record has been put up on order of an amendment petition filed on behalf of plaintiff. Since the suit is at the stage of issuance of the summon for the appearance of two defendants, so rejoinder of this petition is not available on record. The petitioner has prayed in his petition that the name of two sons of deceased defendant no. 6 as well as name and address of husbands of defendant no. 7 and 8 are necessary to add in this plaint. For this purpose there is need of amendment in this plaint. Further the proposed amendments are formal in nature and does not prejudice to the interest of the suit, hence the same may kindly be allowed. The detailed amendment has been asserted in hindi so not produced in translation in this order.</p> <p>Heard the party and perused the record. From perusal of petition as well as case record it transpires that proposed amendments otherwise appear to be grammatical and typing errors which are formal in nature and not changing the nature of the suit. This Court finds that proposed amendments are essential to be included in the pleading of the plaintiff for the just and final determination of the suit. So petition filed on behalf of the plaintiff is here by allowed to achieve the ends of justice on payment of cost of Rs. 200/-.
