By this order we are going to dispose off the anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of accused/ petitioners, namely 1. Pravesh Choudhary, 2. Bechan Choudhary, 3. Domi Choudhary, 4. Chedani Devi @ Neha Devi and 5. Anjali Kumari, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Supaul PS Case No:-435/2025, u/s- 126(2), 115(2), 109, 303(2), 74, 352(2), 3(5) of BNS.

Ld. counsel for the accused/ petitioners argued that accused/ petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no crime and they have falsely been implicated in this case due to dirty village politics. He further submitted that accused/ petitioners have not involved in any other case and having the clean antecedent. He further submitted that the offence as alleged in FIR is not applicable against the accused/ petitioners. It is also submitted that accused/ petitioners are ready to abide by the provisions of section 482 of B.N.S.S, so they may be admitted to the anticipatory bail.

Ld. PP for the State strongly opposed the anticipatory bail application.

In brief, the prosecution story is that on dated 16.08.2025 at about 09:30 P.M., 15 accused persons named in FIR including these accused/ petitioners forcibly entered into the house of the informant and assaulted his mother Tara Devi. The informant further alleged that accused namely Sundar Sharma and Pravesh Choudhary having the *Farsa* assaulted on the head of Tara Devi, thereby she sustained injury on her head and on her eye. Accused Bechan Choudhary also assaulted the informant on head by *Farsa*. When the brother of the informant namely Pince Kumar and father Hari Narayan Choudhary tried to save Tara Devi then accused Domi Choudhary and Ramdev Choudhary also assaulted Hari Naraya Choudhary and accused Pawan Kumar, Shrawan Kumar and Abhishek Kumar assaulted Prince Kumar. Accused Shyamdeo Sharma also torn the clothes of Tara Devi and also snatched silver chain from her.

Argument heard from both sides and perused the lower court record as well as case diary. On perusal of the case diary, it transpires that the police has also recorded the

statement of the witnesses namely Tara Devi, Mahendra Mukhiya and Deo Sevak Mukhiya and all the witnesses have duly supported the prosecution case. Though the allegation against the accused/ petitioners Bechan Choudhary and Pravesh Choudhary that they assaulted the injured/ informant and his mother Tara Devi by *Farsa* on their head, but as per the injury report of injured/ informant Nikhil Kumar and Tara Devi, the doctor has opined the nature of injury of both injureds as simple caused by hard and blunt substance. Similarly, as per the injury report of injured Prince Kumar, the doctor has not found any external injury. As per the supervision report, the police has not found any evidence of snatching the jewelries from the injured Tara Devi. Right from the para No.1 to 56 of the case diary, the I.O has nowhere stated about the previous criminal history of the accused/ petitioners. Both the accused persons and the informant are the neighbours.

Hence, keeping in mind the nature of injury and other surrounding circumstances, I find that all the accused/ petitioners are entitled to get the benefit of anticipatory bail. Therefore, the prayer for anticipatory bail of all accused/ petitioners stands **Allowed** and in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court within 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, they are directed to be released on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.20,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of Learned Court below with condition that they shall abide by all the conditions laid down in section 482 of B.N.S.S and one of the bailor must be family member or close relative.
